Jacob and Hosea See the End of Days!  
December 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024; Kislev 6, 5785  
Genesis 28:10-32; Hosea 12:13-14:10; John 1:41-51

**\*Genesis 28:1-2** Then Isaac called Jacob and blessed him, and charged him, and said to him: You shall not take a wife from the daughters of Canaan. Arise, go to Padan Aram, to the house of Bethuel your mother's father; and take yourself a wife from there of the daughters of Laban your mother's brother.

**\*Genesis 28:10-11** Now Jacob went out from Beersheba and went toward Haran. So he came to the place and stayed there all night, because the sun had set; and he took from the stones of that place and he placed them around his head, and he lay down in that place.

**\*Genesis 22:2** Then He said, "Take now your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, הַמְרִיָּה and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you. So Abraham rose early in the morning and saddled his donkey, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son; and he split the wood for the burnt offering, and arose and went to the place הַמָּקוֹם of which God had told him.

**\*2 Chronicles 3:1:** Then Solomon began to build the temple of the LORD in Jerusalem on Mount Moriah, הַמְרִיָּה where the LORD had appeared to his father David.

**\*2 Chronicles 7: 1** When Solomon finished praying, fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices, and the glory of the LORD filled the house.

**\*John 2:19** Yeshua answered and said to them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.

**2 Samuel 24:20-25** When Araunah looked down, he saw the king and his staff approaching him. Araunah went out, bowed down before the king with his face on the ground, and asked him, "Why has your majesty the king come to his servant?" David replied, "To purchase your threshing floor and to build an altar to the Lord, so the pestilence can be averted from the people." Araunah responded to David, "May your majesty the king take it and offer whatever pleases him. Here are oxen for a burnt offering, along with the threshing sledges and yokes from the oxen for wood! Your majesty, Araunah gives all of this to the king." Araunah also told the king, "May the Lord your God be pleased with you!"

"No!" the king replied to Araunah. "I will buy them from you at full price. I won't offer to the Lord my God burnt offerings that cost me nothing." So David bought the threshing floor



and the oxen for 50 silver shekels built an altar to the Lord there, and presented burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the Lord answered David's prayers for the land and the pestilence on Israel was averted.

**\*Genesis 22:3-4** So Abraham rose early in the morning and saddled his donkey, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son; and he split the wood for the burnt offering, and arose and went to the place of which God had told him. Then on the Abraham raised his eyes and saw the place afar off.

**\*Genesis 22:4** Then on the third day Abraham raised his eyes and saw the place afar off.

**\*Hosea 6:1-2** Come, let us return to the LORD; for he has torn, that he may heal us; he has stricken, and he will bind us up. After two days he will revive us; on the third day he will raise us up, that we may live before him.

**\*John 2:1** On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee.....

**\*Genesis 22:5** And Abraham said to his young men, "Stay here with the donkey; the lad and I will go yonder and worship, and we will come back to you.

**\*Genesis 22:4;7-8** Then on the third day, Abraham lifted his eyes and saw the place afar off. But Isaac spoke to Abraham his father and said, My father! And he said, Here I am, my son. Then he said, Look, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for a burnt offering? And Abraham said, My son, God will provide for Himself the lamb for a burnt offering." So the two of them went together.

**\*Matthew 5:1-7** Seeing the crowds, he went up on the mountain, and when He sat down, His disciples came to him. And He opened his mouth and taught them,.....

**\*Isaiah 2:3** Many people shall come and say, "Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, To the house of the God of Jacob; He will teach us His ways, And we shall walk in His paths." For out of Zion shall go forth the law, And the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.

**\*Genesis 28:10-11** Now Jacob went out from Berrsheba and went toward Haran. So he came to a certain place and stayed there all night because the sun had set. And he took one of the stones of that place (MAKOM) and put it at his head, and he lay down in that place (BAMAKOM) to sleep.

**\*Genesis 15:12** Now when the sun was going down, a deep sleep fell upon Abram; and behold, terror and great darkness fell upon him.



**\*John 9:4** I must work the works of Him who sent Me while it is day; the night is coming when no one can work.

**\*Genesis 28:21** so that I come back to my father's house in peace, then the LORD (THIS IS THE Y-H-V-H - YESHUA) shall be my God.

**\*Hosea 3:5** But afterward the people will return and devote themselves to the LORD their God and to David's descendant, their king. In the last days, they will tremble in awe of the LORD and of his goodness.

**\*Genesis 28:12** And he dreamed, and there appeared a ladder that was set earthward and its top was reaching heavenward; and there appeared angels מַלְאָךְ of God ascending and descending on it.

**\*John 1:51** Then he said to him, "Yes indeed! I tell you that you will see heaven opened and the angels (messengers) of God going up and coming down on the Son of Man!"

**\*John 14:6** Jesus says to him, I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father, but by Me.

**\*Genesis 28:13-15** And then HASHEM ה' was standing over him and He said, I am HASHEM God of Abraham your father and God of Isaac; the ground you are lying upon to you I will give it and to your descendants. Your offspring shall be as the dust of the earth, and you shall burst forth westward and eastward and northward and southward; and all the families of the earth will be blessed through your offspring. Indeed, I am with you; I will guard you in all places that you go; and I will return you to this soil for I will not leave you until then when I will have done that which I have spoken concerning you.

**\*Isaiah 51:23** But I will put it into the hand of those who afflict you, Who have said to you, Lie down, that we may walk over you. And you have laid your body like the ground, and as the street, for those who walk over.

**\*Genesis 28:16-19a** Jacob awoke from his sleep and said, Surely HASHEM is present in this place (ba makom) and I did not know it. And he became frightened and said, How awesome is this place! This is none other than the house of God, and this is the gate of the heavens! Jacob arose early in the morning and he took the stone that he placed at his head and set it up as a monument and he poured oil on its top. And he called the name of that place (Makom) Beth-el.

**\*Revelation 3:17** Because you say I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind and naked—



**\*Hosea 1:9** Then God said: call his name Lo-Ammi. For you are not My people, and I will not be your God.

**\*Hosea 11:9** I will not again destroy Ephraim, for I am God, and not man. The Holy One in your midst. And I will not come with terror. They shall walk after the LORD. He will roar like a lion. When He roars, then His sons shall come trembling from the west; they shall come trembling like a bird from Egypt.

**\*Revelation 5:4-5** (and JOHN SAYS☺) So I wept much, because no one was found worthy to open and read the scroll, or to look at it. But one of the elders said to me, Do not weep. Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the scroll and loose its seven seals.

**\*Hosea 12:2** Ephraim embraces the wind and pursues the east wind all day.

**\*Hosea 12:12** If Gilead suffered destruction, they were but vanity. In Gilead they slaughtered oxen; indeed their altars are like heaps along the furrows of the field.\_

**\*Hosea 13:1-3** When Ephraim spoke, trembling, He exalted himself in Israel; But when he offended through Baal worship, he died. Now they sin more and more, and have made for themselves molded images, idols of their silver, according to their skill; all of it is the work of craftsmen. They say of them, "Let the men who sacrifice kiss the calves! Therefore they shall be like the morning cloud and like the early dew that passes away, like chaff blown off from a threshing floor and like smoke from a chimney.

**\*Hosea 13:8** I will meet them like a bear deprived of her cubs; I will tear open their rib cage, and there I will devour them like a lion. The wild beast shall tear them.

**\*Revelation 6:8** And I saw, and behold, a pale horse: and he that sat upon him, his name was Death; and Hades followed with him. And there was given unto them authority over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with famine, and with death, and by the wild beasts of the earth.

**\*Hosea 14:1-3** O Israel, return to the Lord your God, For you have stumbled because of your iniquity; Take words with you, And return to the Lord. Say to Him, Take away all iniquity; Receive us graciously, For we will offer the sacrifices of our lips. Assyria shall not save us, We will not ride on horses, Nor will we say anymore to the work of our hands, You are our gods.



**\*Hosea 14:4 & 6** I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely, For My anger has turned away from him. His branches shall spread; His beauty shall be like an olive tree, and his fragrance like Lebanon.

**\*Hosea 14:7** Those who dwell under his shadow shall return; They shall be revived like grain, and grow like a vine. Their scent shall be like the wine of Lebanon.
