Exodus 27:20-30:10; I-Samuel 15:2-34; Mark 6:14-29

**\*Revelation 12:11.** It says, And they overcame and conquered him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, for they did not love their life and renounce their faith even when faced with death.

**Micah 4:2** Many nations will come and say, "Come and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord and to the house of the God of Jacob, That He may teach us about His ways And that we may walk in His paths." For from Zion will go forth the law, even the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.

**\*Isaiah 2:2** Now it will come about that in the last days The mountain of the house of the Lord will be established as the chief of the mountains, and will be raised above the hills; and all the nations will stream to it.

**\*Ecclesiastes 1:9** That which has been is what will be, That which is done is what will be done, And there is nothing new under the sun.

**\*Exodus 27:20** And you shall command the Children of Israel that they shall bring to you olive oil that is clear. **(CLEAR IN HEBREW IS PURE)** crushed, for illumination, to light a lamp continually

**\*Isaiah 53:5** But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed.

**\*2 Corinthians 4:8-9** We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed;

**\*Matthew 5:14-16** You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

**\*Revelation 1:4** John, to the seven churches which are in Asia:

**\*Revelation 1:10-11a** I was in the Spirit on the Lord's Day, and I heard behind me a loud voice, as of a trumpet, saying, I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, and, What you see, write in a book and send it to the seven churches.....

**\*Revelation 1:20b** The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands which you saw are the seven churches.

**\*Revelation 2:1-3** To the angel of the church of Ephesus write,

These things says He who holds the seven stars in His right hand, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands: I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. And you have tested those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars; and you have persevered and have patience, and have labored for My name's sake and have not become weary.

**\*Revelation 2:4-6** Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have left your first love. Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place—unless you repent.

**\*Matthew 22:37** And He (said to him, You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.

**\*Revelation 2:8-10** And to the angel of the church in Smyrna write, These things says the First and the Last, who was dead, and came to life: I know your works, tribulation, and poverty (but you are rich); and I know the blasphemy of those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan. Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.

**\*Revelation 2:11** He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

**\*Revelation 2:12-14** And to the angel of the church in Pergamos write,

These things says He who has the sharp two-edged sword: I know your works, and where you dwell, where Satan's throne is. And you hold fast to My name, and did not deny My faith even in the days in which Antipas was My faithful martyr, who was killed among you, where Satan dwells. But I have a few things against you, because you have there those who hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balak to put a stumbling block before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed to idols, and to commit sexual immorality. Thus you also have those who hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans,

**which thing I hate**. Repent, or else I will come to you quickly and will **fight against them with the sword of My mouth**.

**\*Revelation 19:14-15** The armies of heaven, dressed in fine linen, white and pure, follow Him on white horses. **From his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations**, and he will rule them with a rod of iron. He will tread the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God the Almighty.

**\*Revelation 2:18-23** And to the angel of the church in Thyatira write, These things says **the Son of God**, who has eyes like a flame of fire, and His feet like fine brass: I know your works, love, service, faith, and your patience; and as for your works, the last are more than the first. Nevertheless I have a few things against you, because **you allow that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, to teach and seduce My servants to commit sexual immorality and eat things sacrificed to idols**. And I gave her **time to repent** of her sexual immorality, and **she did not repent**. **Indeed I will cast her into a sickbed, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation unless they repent of their deeds**. I will kill her children with death, and **all the churches shall know** that I am He who searches the minds and hearts. And I will give to each one of you according to your works.

**\*Revelation 3:1-5** To the angel of the church in Sardis write, These things says He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars: I know your works, that you have a name that you are alive, **but you are dead**. **Be watchful**, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die, for **I have not found your works perfect** before God. Remember therefore how you have received and heard; hold **fast and repent**. Therefore, **if you will not watch**, I will come upon you as a thief, and you will not know what hour I will come upon you. You have a few names even in Sardis who have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with Me in white, for they are worthy. He who overcomes shall be clothed in white garments, **and I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life**; but I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels.

**\*Revelation 3:7-12** And to the angel of the **church in Philadelphia** write, These things says He who is holy, He who is true, He who has the key of David, He who opens and no one shuts, and shuts and no one opens: I know your works. See, I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it; for you have a little strength, **have kept My word**, and **have not denied My name**. Indeed I will make those of the synagogue of Satan, who say they are Jews and are not, but lie—indeed I will make them come and worship before your feet, and to know that I have loved you. Because **you have kept My command to persevere**, **I also will keep you from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth**. Behold, I am coming quickly! Hold fast what you have, that no one may take your crown. He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall go out no more. I will write on him the name of My God and the name of the city of My God, the New Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God. And I will write on him My new name.

**\*Revelation 3:14-21** And to the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write,

These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: I know your works, that **you are neither cold nor hot**. I could wish you were cold or hot. So then, **because you are lukewarm**, and neither cold nor hot, **I will vomit you out of My mouth**.

Because you say, I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing'—and do not know that **you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked**— I counsel you to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see. As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. **Therefore be zealous and repent**. Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come into him and dine with him, and he with Me. To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.

**\*Exodus 28:1-4** Now take Aaron your brother, and his sons with him, from among the children of Israel, that he may **minister to Me as priest**, Aaron and Aaron's sons: Nadab, Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar. And you shall make **holy garments** for Aaron your brother, for glory and for beauty. So you shall speak to all who are gifted artisans, whom I have filled with the spirit of wisdom, that they may make Aaron's garments, **to consecrate him, that he may minister to Me as priest**. And these are the garments which they shall make: a breastplate, an ephod, a robe, a skillfully woven tunic, a turban, and a sash. So they shall make **holy garments for Aaron your brother and his sons, that he may minister to Me as priest**.

**\*Isaiah 42:6** I, the LORD, have called you for a righteous purpose, and I will take hold of your hand. I will keep you and appoint you to be a covenant for the people and **a light to the nations**,

**\*Revelation 5:8-10** Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. And they sang a new song, saying:

You are worthy to take the scroll,  
And to open its seals;  
For You were slain,  
And have redeemed us to God by Your blood.  
**Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation.**  
**And have made us kings and priests to our God:**  
**And we shall reign on the earth.**

**\*Revelation 20:6** Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but **they shall be priests of God and of Messiah, and shall reign with him a thousand years**.

**\*Isaiah 66:20** Then they shall bring all your brethren for an offering to the Lord **out of all nations**, on horses and in chariots and in litters, on mules and on camels, to My holy mountain Jerusalem, says the Lord, as the children of Israel bring an offering in a clean vessel into the house of the Lord. **And I will also take some of them for priests and Levites, says the Lord.**

**\*Ephesians 6:13-18** Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

**14** Stand therefore, having girded your **waist with truth**, having put on the **breastplate of righteousness**,

**15** and having **shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace**; **16** above all, taking the **shield of faith** with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. And **take the helmet of salvation**, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God;

**18** **praying always** with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints--

**\*Number 27:21**[Joshua] shall stand before Elazar the priest, who shall ask counsel for him after the judgment of the Urim before G-d: by this word shall they go out and by this word they shall come in, both he and all the children of Israel with him.

**\*Revelation 19:11** Then I saw heaven standing open, and there before me was a white horse. And its rider is called Faithful and True. With righteousness **He judges and wages war.**

**\*I John 1:5** This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that **God is light**, and in him is no darkness at all.

**\*Psalm 104:2a** He wraps Himself in light as with a garment;
