Signs of Messiah's Coming and the Fall of Mystery Babylon  
May 24, 2025; Iyyar 26, 5785  
Lev. 21:1-24:23; Ezekiel 44:15-31; Matthew 26:20-28

**\*Leviticus 25:1-4a;6-7** And the Lord spoke to Moses on Mount Sinai, saying, "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'When you come into the land which I give you, then the land shall keep a sabbath to the Lord. Six years you shall sow your field, and six years you shall prune your vineyard, and gather its fruit; **but in the seventh year there shall be a sabbath of solemn rest for the land, a sabbath to the Lord....** <sup>6</sup> And the sabbath produce of the land shall be food for you: for you, your male and female servants, your hired man, and the stranger who dwells with you, <sup>7</sup> for your livestock and the beasts that are in your land—all its produce shall be for food.

**\*Leviticus 25:8-9** And you shall count seven sabbaths of years for yourself, seven times seven years; and the time of the seven sabbaths of years shall be to you forty-nine years. <sup>9</sup> Then you shall cause the trumpet of the Jubilee to sound on the tenth day of the seventh month; on the Day of Atonement you shall make the trumpet to sound throughout all your land.

**\*Daniel 9:24-27** Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.

<sup>25</sup> Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and sixty-two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

<sup>26</sup> And after sixty-two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

<sup>27</sup> And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering, and on the wing of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

**\*Genesis 3:15** And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed) and her seed. He will crush your head, and you will strike his heel.

**\*Revelation 12:5** bore a male Child who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron.  
And her Child was caught up to God and His throne.

**\*Revelation 12:4** His tail drew a third of the stars of heaven and threw them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman who was ready to give birth, to devour her Child as soon as it was born.

**\*Matthew 2:13b** Now when they had departed, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream, saying, "Arise, take the young Child and His mother, flee to Egypt, and stay there until I bring you word; for Herod will seek the young Child to destroy Him.

**\*Daniel 2:31-42 selections** "You, O king, were watching; and behold, a great image! This great image, whose splendor was excellent, stood before you; and its form was awesome. .... **37**You, O king, are a king of kings. For the God of heaven has given you a kingdom, power, strength, and glory; **38**and wherever the children of men dwell, or the beasts of the field and the birds of the heaven, He has given them into your hand, and has made you ruler over them all—you are this head of gold. **39**But after you shall arise another kingdom inferior to yours; then another, a third kingdom of bronze, which shall rule over all the earth. **40**And the fourth kingdom shall be as strong as iron, inasmuch as iron breaks in pieces and shatters everything; and like iron that crushes, that kingdom will break in pieces and crush all the others.... **44** In the days of those kings, the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that will never be destroyed, nor will it be left to another people. It will shatter all these kingdoms and bring them to an end, but will itself stand forever.

**\*Matthew 24:6-7** You will hear of wars and rumors of wars, but see to it that you are not alarmed. These things must happen, but the end is still to come. Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be famines and earthquakes in various places....

**\*Zephaniah 3:6** I have cut off the nations; their corner towers are destroyed. I have made their streets deserted with no one to pass through. Their cities are laid waste, with no man, no inhabitant.

**\*Zephaniah 3:7** I said, Surely you will fear Me, You will receive instruction— So that her dwelling would not be cut off, Despite everything for which I punished her. But they rose early and corrupted all their deeds.

**\*Matthew 23:39** For I tell you that you will not see Me again until you say, 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord.'
