The Signs of His Coming Are Everywhere - An Explosive Prophecy Revealed!

Numbers 19:1-22:1; Judges 11:1-33; John 2:1-12

**\*Numbers 20:1** Then the children of Israel, the whole congregation, came into the Wilderness of Zin in the first month, and the people stayed in Kadesh; and Miriam died there and was buried there.

**\*John 12:24** But Yeshua replied, The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. Truly, truly, I tell you, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a seed. But if it dies, it bears much fruit.

**\*Numbers 20:2** Now there was no water for the congregation; so they gathered together against Moses and Aaron. **3** And the people contended with Moses and spoke, saying: If only we had died when our brethren died before the Lord!

**\*Micah 6:4** For I brought you up from the land of Egypt, I redeemed you from the house of bondage; And I sent before you Moses, Aaron, and Miriam.

**\*John 7:37-38** Now on the last day, the great day of the feast, Yeshua stood and cried out, saying, If anyone is thirsty, let him come to Me and drink. He who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, From his innermost being will flow rivers of living water.

**\*John 4:13-14** But whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life.

**\*Numbers 20:17** Then Israel sang this song: "Spring up, O well, all of you sing to it!"

**\*Deuteronomy 8:3** And he humbled you and let you hunger and fed you with manna, which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that he might make you know that man does not live by bread alone, but man lives by every word that comes from the mouth of the LORD.

**\*John 1:1-2** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God.

**\*John 6:35** Yeshua said to them, I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in me shall never thirst.

**\*John 6:51** I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. And the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh.

**\*Exodus 13:21-22** And the Lord went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead them along the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, that they might travel by day and by night. The pillar of cloud by day and the pillar of fire by night did not depart from before the people.

**\*I Corinthians 10:1-3** For I do not want you to be unaware, brothers, that our fathers were all under the cloud, and all passed through the sea, and all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea, and all ate the same spiritual food, and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank from the spiritual Rock that followed them, and the Rock was Messiah.

**\*Exodus 13:21** Sometimes the cloud was a few days over the tabernacle, and according to the command of the LORD they remained in camp; then according to the command of the LORD they set out.

**\*Exodus 32:25-29** Now when Moses saw that the people were unrestrained (for Aaron had not restrained them, to their shame among their enemies), then Moses stood in the entrance of the camp, and said, 'Whoever is on the Lord's side—come to me!' And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together to him. And he said to them, 'Thus says the Lord God of Israel: "Let every man put his sword on his side, and go in and out from entrance to entrance throughout the camp, and let every man kill his brother, every man his companion, and every man his neighbor.'" So the sons of Levi did according to the word of Moses. And about three thousand men of the people fell that day. Then Moses said, 'Consecrate yourselves today to the Lord, that He may bestow on you a blessing this day, for every man has opposed his son and his brother.'

**\*Psalm 106:19-23** They made a calf in Horeb and worshiped the molded image. Thus, they changed their glory into the image of an ox that eats grass. They forgot God their Savior, Who had done great things in Egypt, wondrous works in the land of Ham, awesome things by the Red Sea. Therefore, He said that He would destroy them, had not Moses His chosen one stood before Him in the breach, to turn away His wrath, lest He destroy them."

**\*Numbers 19:1-2** G-d spoke to Moses and to Aaron, saying: This is the chok of the Torah which G-d has commanded.

Speak to the children of Israel, that they bring to you a red heifer without defect, in which there is no blemish, and upon which never came a yoke.

**\*Ephesians 5:2** And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.

**\*Hebrews 7:26-28** For it was indeed fitting that we should have such a high priest, holy, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, and exalted above the heavens. He has no need, like those high priests, to offer sacrifices daily, first for his own sins and then for those of the people, since he did this once for all when he offered up himself.

**\*Numbers 19:3** You shall give her to Elazar the priest, that he may bring her outside the camp, and she shall be slaughtered before him.

**\*Hebrews 13:12** And so Yeshua also suffered outside the camp, to sanctify the people by His own blood.

**\*Numbers 19:5-6** Then the heifer shall be burned in his sight: its hide, its flesh, its blood, and its offal shall be burned and the priest shall take cedar wood and hyssop and scarlet and cast them into the midst of the fire burning the heifer.

**\*Psalm 22:6** But I am a worm, and no man; A reproach of men, and despised by the people.

**\*Philippians 2:6-7** Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

**\*Psalm 82:1** God stands in the congregation of the divine assembly; He judges among the divine beings. How long will you judge unjustly, and show partiality to the wicked?

**\*Corinthians 5:21** For our sake He made Him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

**\*Psalm 82:2-3** How long will you judge unjustly, and show partiality to the wicked? *Selah* Defend the poor and fatherless; do justice to the afflicted and needy. Deliver the poor and needy; free them from the hand of the wicked.

**\*Psalm 82:5-6** They do not know, nor do they understand; they walk about in darkness; all the foundations of the earth totter.

**\*Isaiah 9:16** For those who guide this people mislead them, and those they mislead are swallowed up.

**\*Matthew 15:14** Disregard them! They are blind guides. If a blind man leads a blind man, both will fall into a pit--all the foundations of the earth are unstable.

**\*Proverbs 11:19** Truly the righteous attain life, but whoever pursues evil finds death.

**\*Matthew 24:31-46** "When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit on his glorious throne. <sup>32</sup> All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate the people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. <sup>33</sup> He will put the sheep on his right and the goats on his left.

<sup>34</sup> "Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world. <sup>35</sup> For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, <sup>36</sup> I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.'

<sup>37</sup> "Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? <sup>38</sup> When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? <sup>39</sup> When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?'

<sup>40</sup> "The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.'

<sup>41</sup> "Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels. <sup>42</sup> For I was hungry and you gave me nothing to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me nothing to drink, <sup>43</sup> I was a stranger and you did not invite me in, I needed clothes and you did not clothe me, I was sick and in prison and you did not look after me.'

<sup>44</sup> "They also will answer, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or needing clothes or sick or in prison, and did not help you?'

<sup>45</sup> "He will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me.'

<sup>46</sup> "Then they will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life.

**\*Psalm 82:6** I said, You are gods, and all of you are children of the Most High. But you shall die like men, and fall like one of the princes.

**\*Psalm 82:8** Arise, O God, judge the earth; for You shall inherit all nations.

**\*Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 To everything there is a season, a time for every purpose under heaven:**

**2**A time to be born,  
And a time to die;  
A time to plant,  
And a time to pluck *what is* planted;

**3**A time to kill,  
And a time to heal;  
A time to break down,  
And a time to build up;

**4**A time to weep,  
And a time to laugh;
