The Zeal of the LORD in the Last Days; Pt. 3 War of Gog and Megog

Numbers 25:10-30:1; Jeremiah 1:1-2:3; LUKE 13:1-10

***Exodus 6:25** Aaron's son Eleazar married one of the daughters of Putiel, and she bore him Phinehas. These were the heads of the Levite families by their clans.

***Numbers 24:14** And now, indeed, I am going to my people. Come, I will advise you what this people will do to your people in the latter days.

***Revelation 2:13a-14** I know your works and where you dwell, where Satan's throne is..... Nevertheless, I have a few things against you: There are some among you who hold to the teaching of Balaam, who taught Balak to entice the Israelites to sin by eating food sacrificed to idols and committing sexual immorality.

***Revelation 2:16** Repent, or else I will come to you quickly and will fight against them with the sword of My mouth.

***Numbers 24:25** Then Balaam arose and returned to his homeland, and Balak also went on his way.

***Numbers 25:1-3** Now Israel remained in Acacia Grove, and the people began to commit harlotry with the women of Moab. They invited the people to the sacrifices of their gods, and the people ate and bowed down to their gods. So Israel was joined to Baal of Peor, and the anger of the Lord was aroused against Israel.

***1 Corinthians 10:8** We should not commit sexual immorality, as some of them did, and in one day twenty-three thousand of them died.

***Psalm 106:28-29** They yoked themselves to Baal of Peor and ate sacrifices offered to lifeless gods. So they provoked the LORD to anger with their deeds, and a plague broke out among them.

***Numbers 25:4-5** Then the LORD said to Moses, "Take all the leaders of the people and execute them in broad daylight before the LORD, so that His fierce anger may turn away from Israel." So Moses told the judges of Israel, "Each of you must kill all of his men who have joined in worshiping Baal of Peor."...

***2 Peter 2:15** They have left the straight way and wandered off to follow the way of Balaam son of Bezer, who loved the wages of wickedness.

***Jude 1:11** Woe to them! They have taken the way of Cain; they have rushed for profit into Balaam's error; they have been destroyed in Korah's rebellion.

***Matthew 6:33** But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added unto you.

***Numbers 25:1-3** While Israel was staying in Shittim, the men began to indulge in sexual immorality with the daughters of Moab, who also invited them to the sacrifices for their gods. And the people ate and bowed down to these gods.³ So Israel joined in worshiping Baal of Peor, and the anger of the LORD burned against them.

***Numbers 24:21-24** ²¹Next he saw the Kenites and lifted up an oracle, saying: "Your dwelling place is strong, and your nest is set in a rock. ²²Yet Kenite will be destroyed when Asshur (SYRIA, LEBANON, TURKEY, IRAQ AND IRAN) takes you captive. ²³Once more Balaam lifted up an oracle, saying: Ah, who can live unless God has ordained it? ²⁴Ships will come from the coasts of KITTIM; they will subdue Asshur and it will inflict the other bank, but they too will perish forever.

***Genesis 10:4-5** And the sons of Javan: Elishah, Tarshish, the Kittites, and the Rodanites. From these, the maritime peoples separated into their territories, according to their languages, by clans within their nations....

***Numbers 25:2...** who also invited them to the sacrifices for their gods. And the people ate and bowed down to these gods. So Israel joined in worshiping Baal of Peor, and the anger of the LORD burned against them.

***Numbers 25:6-8** ⁶Just then an Israelite man brought to his family a Midianite woman in the sight of Moses and the whole congregation of Israel while they were weeping at the entrance to the Tent of Meeting.⁷ On seeing this, Phinehas son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest, got up from the assembly, took a spear in his hand, ⁸followed the Israelite into his tent, and drove the spear through both of them—through the Israelite and on through the belly of the woman. So the plague against the Israelites was halted, ⁹but those who died in the plague numbered 24,000.

***1 Kings 19:9-10** Then he came there to a cave and lodged there; and behold, the word of the LORD came to him, and He said to him, "What are you doing here, Elijah?" He said, "I have been very zealous for the LORD, the God of hosts; for the sons of Israel have forsaken Your covenant, torn down Your altars and killed Your prophets with the sword. And I alone am left; and they seek my life, to take it away."

***I Kings 19:18** Yet I have reserved seven thousand in Israel, all whose knees have not bowed to Baal, and every mouth that has not kissed him.

***Genesis 45:7** God sent me before you to preserve you as a remnant on the earth and to save your lives by a great deliverance.

***John 2:13-17** The Passover of the Jews was near, and Yeshua went up to Jerusalem. And He found in the temple those who were selling oxen and sheep and doves, and the money changers seated at their tables. And He made a scourge of cords, and drove them all out of the temple, with the sheep and the oxen; and He poured out the coins of the money changers and overturned their tables....

***Numbers 25:9-13** Then the LORD said to Moses, "Phinehas son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest, has turned My wrath away from the Israelites; for he was zealous for My sake among them, so that I did not consume the Israelites in My zeal. Declare, therefore, that I am granting him My covenant of peace. It will be a covenant of permanent priesthood for him and his descendants, because he was zealous for his God and made atonement for the Israelites."

***Ezekiel 2:1&9** And He said to me, Son of man, stand on your feet, and I will speak to you. Then the Spirit entered me when He spoke to me, and set me on my feet; and I heard Him who spoke to me.

***Ezekiel 2:9-3:3** Now when I looked, there was a hand stretched out to me; and behold, a scroll of a book was in it. Then He spread it before me; and there was writing on the inside and on the outside and written on it were lamentations and mourning and woe. Moreover, He said to me, Son of man, eat what you find; eat this scroll, and go, speak to the house of Israel. So I opened my mouth, and He caused me to eat that scroll. And He said to me, "Son of man, feed your belly, and fill your stomach with this scroll that I give you." So I ate, and it was in my mouth sweet.

***Revelation 10:10** So I took the small scroll from the angel's hand and ate it, and it was as sweet as honey in my mouth. But when I had eaten it, my stomach turned bitter.

***Ezekiel 8:3-5** He stretched out the form of a hand, and took me by a lock of my hair; and the Spirit lifted me up between earth and heaven, and brought me in visions of God to Jerusalem, to the door of the north gate of the inner court, where the seat of the provocative image of Provocation stood, ⁴ And behold, the glory of the God of Israel was there, like the vision that I saw in the plain. ⁵ Then He said to me, "Son of man, lift your eyes now toward the north." So I lifted my eyes toward the north, and there, north of the altar gate, was this image of jealousy in the entrance.

***Isaiah 1:15b** your hands are full of blood.... 1:16b cease to do evil; 1:17 seek justice; 1:21 How the faithful city has become a harlot. It was full of justice; righteousness lodged in it, but now murderers....1:26 I will restore your judges as at the first and your counselors as at the first. 1:18 Afterward you shall be called the city of righteousness, the faithful city. 1:27 Zion shall be redeemed with justice.....

***Isaiah 2:21** say To go into the clefts of the rocks, And into the crags of the rugged rocks, from the terror of the Lord And the glory of His majesty, when He arises to shake the earth mightily.

***Isaiah 1:17-19** The loftiness of man shall be bowed down, and the haughtiness of men shall be brought low; the LORD alone will be exalted in that day, But the idols He shall utterly abolish. They shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, from the terror of the LORD and the glory of His majesty, when He arises to shake the earth mightily.

***Revelation 6:14-16** And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places. And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains; and said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of Him that sits on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

***Ezekiel 36:1-2a,5** And you, son of man, prophesy to the mountains of Israel, and say, O mountains of Israel, hear the word of the LORD! Thus says the Lord God: "Because the enemy has said of you, 'Aha! The ancient heights have become our possession'," " ³ therefore prophesy, and say, 'Thus says the Lord God: "Because they made you desolate and swallowed you up on every side, so that you became the possession of the rest of the nations, ⁵ therefore thus says the Lord God: Surely I have spoken in My burning jealousy against the rest of the nations and against all Edom, who gave My land to themselves as a possession, with wholehearted joy and spiteful minds, in order to plunder its open country.

***Ezekiel 36:9-12** ⁹ For indeed I am for you, and I will turn to you, and you shall be tilled and sown. ¹⁰ I will multiply men upon you, all the house of Israel, all of it; and the cities shall be inhabited and the ruins rebuilt. ¹¹ I will multiply upon you man and beast; and they shall increase and bear young; I will make you inhabited as in former times and do better for you than at your beginnings. Then you shall know that I am the Lord. ¹² Yes, I will cause men to walk on you, My people Israel; they shall take possession of you, and you shall be their inheritance; no more shall you bereave them of children."

***Ezekiel 38:8** After many days you will be visited. In the latter years you will come into the land of those brought back from the sword and gathered from many people on the mountains of Israel, which had long been desolate; they were brought out of the nations, and now all of them dwell safely.

***I Peter 3: 14-15a** But even if you should suffer for righteousness' sake, you are blessed. And do not be afraid of their threats, nor be troubled. But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;

***Ephesians 6:7** Serve wholeheartedly, as if you were serving the Lord, not people.
