

Congregation Notes Mattot Maessei The War of the Righteous as We Await the Messiah's Return and Part 4 Gog and Megog War! July 26, 2025; Av 1, 5785 Numbers 30:2-36:13; Jeremiah 2:4-3:4; Mark 11:12-25

\*Numbers 30:1-3 Then Moses spoke to the heads of the tribes concerning the children of Israel, saying, "This is the thing which the LORD has commanded: <sup>2</sup> If a man makes a vow to the LORD, or swears an oath to bind himself by some agreement, <u>he shall not break his word</u>; he shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth.

\*Genesis 1:3 Then God said, Let there be light and there was.

\*Jeremiah 9:2-5 Oh, that I had in the wilderness A lodging place for travelers; That I might leave my people, and go from them! For they are all adulterers, an assembly of treacherous men. <sup>3</sup> And like their bow <u>they have bent their tongues for lies</u>. They are not valiant for the <u>truth on the earth</u>. For they proceed from evil to evil, and <u>they do not know Me</u>, says the LORD. <sup>4</sup> "Everyone take heed to his neighbor, and <u>do not trust any brother</u>; for every brother will utterly supplant, and every neighbor will walk with slanderers. <sup>5</sup> Everyone will deceive his neighbor and <u>will not speak the truth; They have taught their tongue to speak lies</u>; They weary themselves to commit iniquity.

\*Ecclesiastes 5:4-5 When you make a vow to God, do not delay to pay it; for He has no pleasure in fools.

Pay what you have vowed— Better not to vow than to vow and not pay.

\*Ecclesiastes 5:2-3 Do not be rash with your mouth, And let not your heart utter anything hastily before God. For God is in heaven, and you on earth; Therefore let your words be few. For a dream comes through much activity, and a fool's voice is known by his many words.

\*I Corinthians 10:11 Now all these things happened to them as examples, and <u>they were</u> written for our admonition, <u>upon whom the ends of the ages have come</u>.

\*Numbers 31:1-6 And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying: <u>Avenge with the vengeance</u> of the children of Israel against the Midianites; <u>afterward you shall be gathered to your</u> <u>people</u>. So Moses spoke to the people, saying, Arm some of yourselves for war, and let them go against the Midianites to take vengeance for the LORD on Midian. <sup>4</sup> A thousand from each tribe of all the tribes of Israel you shall send to the war. <sup>5</sup> So there were recruited from the

divisions of Israel one thousand from each tribe, <u>twelve thousand armed for war</u>.<sup>6</sup> Then Moses sent them to the war, one thousand from each tribe; he sent them to the war with <u>Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest, the Kohen to the army year and the vessels of the</u> <u>Sancturary and the trumpets for sounding short blasts were in his hand.</u>

**\*Psalm 24:10** Who is this King of glory? <u>The LORD of hosts</u>, אָבָא<mark></mark>ות. He is the King of glory. Selah

\*Jeremiah 35:17a Therefore this is what the LORD God of Hosts, the God of Israel, says

\*Exodus 12:17 So you shall observe the Feast of Unleavened Bread, for on this same day I will have brought your armies out of the land of Egypt.

**\*Exodus 12:41** And it came to pass at the end of the four hundred and thirty years—on that very same day—it came to pass that <u>all the armies of the LORD</u> went out from the land of Egypt.

\*Numbers 31:8 They killed the kings of Midian with the rest of those who were killed-- Evi, Rekem, Zur, Hur, and Reba, the five kings of Midian. <u>Balaam the son of Beor they also killed</u> with the sword.

\*Genesis 13:16 I will make your offspring like the dust of the earth, so that <u>if one could</u> <u>count the dust of the earth, then your offspring could be counted</u>.

\*Psalm 37:4 Delight yourself in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart.

\*Psalm 119:10 I seek you with all my heart; do not let me stray from your commands.

\*Proverbs 23:4 Do not wear yourself out to get rich; do not trust your own cleverness.

\*Proverbs 16:3 Commit to the Lord whatever you do, and he will establish your plans.

\*Proverbs 28:14 How blessed is the man who fears always, But <u>he who hardens his heart will fall into calamity</u>.

\*Ephesians 4:18 They are darkened in their understanding, alienated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, due to their hardness of heart.

\*Psalm 19:12 Who can discern his errors? Acquit me of hidden faults.

\*Ephesians 4:24...and put on the new self, which in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth.

## \*Galatians 5:16 I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

**\*Psalm 2:1-3** Why do the nations rage, <u>and the people plot a vain thing</u>? The kings of the earth set themselves,

and the rulers take counsel together, <u>against the LORD and against His Anointed</u>, saying, Let us break their bonds in pieces and cast away their cords from us.

\*Ezekiel 38:1–3 Now the word of the LORD came to me, saying, "Son of man, set your face against <u>Gog, of the land of Magog</u>, the <u>prince of Rosh</u>, <u>Meshech</u>, and <u>Tubal</u>, and prophesy against him,.....

\*Genesis 10:2 The sons of Japheth were Gomer, Magog, Madai, Javan, Tubal, Meshech, and Tiras.

\*Genesis 38:3-4 <u>3</u>and say, 'Thus says the Lord God: "Behold, I am against you, O Gog, the prince of Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal. <u>4I will turn you around, put hooks into your jaws, and lead you out, with all your army, horses, and horsemen, all splendidly clothed, a great company with bucklers and shields, all of them handling swords.</u>

\*Genesis 38:5-6 <u>Persia, Cush, and Put</u> are with them, all of them with shield and helmet; <u>6</u>Gomer and all its troops; the <u>house of Togarmah from the far north</u> and all its troops—many people are with you.

\*Ezekiel 38: 7-9 "Prepare yourself and be ready, you and all your companies that are gathered about you; and be a guard for them. <u>8</u>After many days you will be visited. <u>In the</u> <u>latter years you will come into the land of those brought back from the</u> <u>sword and gathered from many people on the mountains of Israel, which had long been</u> <u>desolate; they were brought out of the nations, and now all of them dwell safely 9</u>You will <u>ascend, coming like a storm, covering the land like a cloud, you and all your troops and</u> <u>many peoples with you.</u>"

\*Ezekiel 38:10-12 Thus says the Lord God: "On that day it shall come to pass that <u>thoughts</u> <u>will arise in your mind, and you will make an evil plan</u>: <u>11</u>You will say, 'I will go up against a land of unwalled villages; I will go to a peaceful people, who dwell safely, all of them dwelling without walls, and having neither bars nor gates'—<u>12to take plunder and to take</u> <u>booty</u>,.....who have acquired goods, who dwell in the midst of the land;

\*Ezekiel 38:14–16 "Therefore, son of man, prophesy and say to Gog, 'Thus says the Lord God: "On that day <u>when My people Israel dwell safely</u>, will you not know it? <u>15Then you will come</u> <u>from your place out of the far north</u>, you and many peoples with you, all of them riding on horses, a great company and a mighty army. <u>16You will come up against My people Israel</u> like a cloud, to cover the land. <u>It will be in the latter days that I will bring you against My</u> <u>land, so that the nations may know Me when I show Myself holy in you before their eyes</u> <u>Gog.</u>

\*Ezekiel 38:18-23 18 "And it will come to pass at the same time, when Gog comes against the land of Israel," says the Lord God, "that <u>My fury will show in My face</u>. 19 For in My jealousy and in the fire of My wrath I have spoken: <u>'Surely in that day there</u> shall be a great earthquake in the land of Israel, 20 so that the fish of the sea, the birds of the heavens, the beasts of the field, all creeping things that creep on the earth, and all men who are on the face of the earth shall shake at My presence. The mountains shall be thrown down, the steep places shall fall, and every wall shall fall to the ground.<sup>1</sup>21 I will call for a

<u>sword against Gog throughout all My mountains,</u>" says the Lord God. "Every man's sword will be against his brother.

22 And <u>I will bring him to judgment</u> with pestilence and bloodshed; <u>I will rain down on him</u>, on his troops, and on the many peoples who are with him, <u>flooding rain, great hailstones, fire,</u> <u>and brimstone</u>.

23 Thus **I will magnify Myself and sanctify Myself**, THE and I will be known in the eyes of many nations. **Then they shall know that I am the Lord**."

\*Psalm 91:7-11 A thousand may fall at your side, And ten thousand at your right hand; <u>but it</u> <u>shall not come near you</u>. Only with your eyes shall you look and see the reward of the wicked. Because you have made the Lord, who is my refuge, even the Most High, your dwelling place, <u>No evil shall befall you, nor shall any plague come near your dwelling</u>; for <u>He shall</u> <u>give His angels charge over you</u>, <u>to keep you in all your ways</u>.
