The Lord is Speaking! Prophecy Is All Lining Up On This Shabbat!

Feb 28, 2026; Adar 11, 5786

Exod. 27:20-30:10; I Sam. 15:2-34; Mark 6 14-29

***Deuteronomy 25:17** Remember what Amalek did to you on the way as you were coming out of Egypt.

***Romans 4:2-3** For if Abraham was justified by works, he had something to boast about—but not before God.³ What does Scripture say? “Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness.”¹

***Romans 4:9-11** Is this blessedness only for the circumcised, or also for the uncircumcised? We have been saying that Abraham's faith was credited to him as righteousness.¹⁰ Under what circumstances was it credited? Was it after he was circumcised, or before? It was not after, but before!¹¹ And he received circumcision as a sign, a seal of the righteousness that he had by faith while he was still uncircumcised. So then, he is the father of all who believe but have not been circumcised, in order that righteousness might be credited to them.

***Romans 4:6-8** David says the same thing when he speaks of the blessedness of the one to whom God credits righteousness apart from works:⁷ Blessed are those whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.⁸ Blessed is the one whose sin the Lord will never count against them.

***Genesis 15:12** Now when the sun was going down, a deep sleep fell upon Abram; and behold, horror and great darkness fell upon him.

***Malachi 4:1-3** For behold, the day is coming, burning like a furnace, when all the arrogant and every evildoer will be stubble; the day is coming when I will set them ablaze, says the LORD of Hosts. Not a root or branch will be left to them. **2** But to you who fear My name The Sun of Righteousness shall arise with healing in His wings; and you shall go out and grow fat like stall-fed calves.³ Then you will trample the wicked, for they will be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day I am preparing,” says the LORD of Hosts....

***Revelation 1:16** He held in His right hand seven stars, and a sharp double-edged sword came from His mouth. His face was like the sun shining at its brightest.

***Numbers 21:8** Then the LORD said to Moses, Make a fiery serpent and mount it on a pole. When anyone who is bitten looks at it, he will live.

***Psalm 103:1-3** Bless the LORD O my soul; And all that is within me, bless His holy name!

² Bless the LORD O my soul, And forget not all His benefits:

³ Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases,...

***Deuteronomy 7:7** The LORD did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any other people, for you were the least of all peoples.

***I Corinthians 3:16** Do you not know that you yourselves are God's temple, and the Spirit of God dwells in you?

¹⁷If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy him; for God's temple is holy, and you are that temple....

***Exodus 27:20** And you shall command the children of Israel that they bring you pure oil of pressed olives for the light, to cause the lamp to burn continually.

***Revelation 1:12-13** ¹²Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking with me. And having turned, I saw seven golden lampstands, ¹³and among the lampstands was One like the Son of Man, dressed in a long robe, with a golden sash around His chest....

***Exodus 29:4/Numbers 28:3-4**(which expanded the Exodus commandment) Present two unblemished year-old male lambs as a regular burnt offering each day, one in the morning and the other at twilight.

***Genesis 8:20-21** Then Noah built an altar to the LORD. And taking from every kind of clean animal and clean bird, he offered burnt offerings on the altar. ²¹When the LORD smelled the pleasing aroma, He said in His heart, "Never again will I curse the ground because of man, even though every inclination of his heart is evil from his youth. And never again will I destroy all living creatures as I have done....

***John 1:29** The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!

***Hebrews 9:28** Messiah also, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time for salvation without reference to sin, to those who eagerly await Him.

***I Corinthians 6:19** Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; ²⁰you were bought at a price. Therefore glorify God with your body....

Luke 4:18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor. He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed. . . .

***Acts 10:38** how **God anointed Jesus of Nazareth** with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him. **Again, reference is made to anointing—an act normally done with oil—**

***Proverbs 6:23** For the commandment is a lamp, and the Torah is light; and reproofs of instruction are the way of life.

***Matthew 25:1-13** ¹ Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. ² Now five of them were wise, and five were foolish. ³ Those who were foolish took their lamps and took no oil with them, ⁴ but **the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps**. ⁵ But while the bridegroom was delayed, they all slumbered and slept. ⁶ And at midnight a cry was heard: 'Behold, the bridegroom is coming; go out to meet him!' ⁷ Then all those virgins arose and trimmed their lamps. ⁸ And the foolish said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' ⁹ But the wise answered, saying, 'No, lest there should not be enough for us and you; but go rather to those who sell, and buy for yourselves.' ¹⁰ And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding; and the door was shut. ¹¹ Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open to us!' ¹² But he answered and said, 'Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you.' ¹³ Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming.

***Acts 5:32** And we are His witnesses to these things, and so also is the Holy Spirit whom God has given to those who obey Him.

***Psalm 51:11** Do not cast me away from Your presence, And do not take Your Holy Spirit from me.

***Matthew 15:14:** Let them alone; they are blind guides. And if the blind lead the blind, both will fall into a pit.

***Hebrew 12:14** Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord.

***Mark 12:31-32** **30** Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength. The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' No other commandment is greater than these.

***I Corinthians 16:14** Let all that you do be done in love.

***Isaiah 11:3** His delight *is* in the fear of the Lord, and He shall not judge by the sight of His eyes, nor decide by the hearing of His ears;

***Matthew 5:14-16** You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.

***Deuteronomy 25:17** Remember what Amalek did to you on the way as you were coming out of Egypt.

***Exodus 17:16** for he said, Because the LORD has sworn: the LORD will have war with Amalek from generation to generation.

***Esther 9:28** that these days should be remembered and kept throughout every generation, every family, every province, and every city, that these days of Purim should not fail to be observed among the Jews, and that the memory of them should not perish among their descendants.

***Psalm 80:13- 14** The boar from the forest tears it apart; wild creatures from the fields feed on it.

For what can be seen is temporary, but what cannot be seen is eternal.
