How Do We Get the Power to Live Through the End Times?

May 30, 2026, Sivan 14, 5786

Num. 4:21-7:89; Jdg, 13:2-25 | Lk1:11-20

***Numbers 3:14-15** Then the LORD spoke to Moses in the Wilderness of Sinai, saying, / **Number the Levites by their families and clans.** You are to count every male a month old or more.

***Numbers 4:21-22** Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying: 22 Also **take a census of the sons of Gershon,** by their fathers' house, by their families.

***Numbers 4:25-26** **They are to carry the curtains** of the tabernacle, the Tent of Meeting with the **covering of fine leather** over it, **the curtains for the entrance to the Tent of Meeting,** 26 the **curtains of the courtyard, and the curtains for the entrance at the gate of the courtyard** that surrounds the tabernacle and altar, along **with their ropes and all the equipment for their service.** The Gershonites will do all that needs to be done with these items.

***Numbers 3:36-37** And the **appointed duty** of the children of **Merari** included the boards of the tabernacle, its bars, its pillars, its sockets, its utensils, all the work relating to them, ³⁷ and the pillars of the court all around, with their sockets, their pegs, and their cords.

***Numbers 4:1-3** Then the LORD said to Moses and Aaron, 2) **Take a census of the Kohathites** among the Levites by their clans and families, 3) men from thirty to fifty years old—everyone who is qualified to serve in the work at the Tent of Meeting.

***Numbers 4:4** This is the service of the sons of Kohath in the tent of meeting: **the most holy things.**

***Numbers 4:15** And when Aaron and his sons have finished covering the sanctuary and all the furnishings of the sanctuary, when the camp is set to go, then the sons of Kohath shall come to carry them; but they shall not touch any holy thing, **lest they die.** These *are* the things in the tabernacle of meeting which the sons of Kohath are to carry.

***I Samuel 6:1-3 and 19** Now the ark of the Lord was in the country of the Philistines seven months. ² And the Philistines

¹³ Now the people of Beth Shemesh were reaping their wheat harvest in the valley; and **they lifted their eyes and saw the ark, and rejoiced to see it.**

¹⁹ Then **He struck the men of Beth Shemesh, because they had looked into the ark of the LORD. He struck fifty thousand and seventy men of the people,** and the people lamented because the LORD had struck the people with a great slaughter. ²⁰ And the men of Beth Shemesh said, Who is able to stand before this **holy Lord God?**

***2 Samuel 6:1-17** Again David gathered all the choice men of Israel, thirty thousand. ² And David arose and went with all the people who were with him from Baale Judah **to bring up from there the ark of God, whose name is called by the Name, the LORD of Hosts, who dwells between the cherubim.** ³ So they **set the ark of God on a new cart,** and brought it out of the house of Abinadab, which **was on the hill;** and Uzzah and Ahio, the sons of Abinadab, drove the new cart. ⁴ And they brought it out of the

house of Abinadab, which **was on the hill**, accompanying the ark of God; and Ahio went before the ark. ⁵ Then David and all the house of Israel played music before the LORD on all kinds of instruments of fir wood, on harps, on stringed instruments, on tambourines, on sistrums, and on cymbals.

⁶ And when they came to **Nachon's threshing floor. Uzzah put out his hand to the ark of God and took hold of it, for the oxen stumbled.** ⁷ **Then the anger of the LORD was aroused against Uzzah, and God struck him there for his error; and he died there by the ark of God.** ⁸ And David became angry because of the LORD's outbreak against Uzzah; and he called the name of the place Perez Uzzah to this day. ⁹ **David was afraid of the LORD that day;**

***Numbers 4:4&15c** This is the service of the sons of Kohath in the tabernacle of meeting, **relating to the most holy things:.....then the sons of Kohath shall come to carry them; but they shall not touch any holy thing, lest they die.**

***Revelation 4:8** And the four living creatures, each of them with six wings, are full of eyes all around and within. And **day and night they never cease to say, 'Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come!'**

***Leviticus 16:2** The LORD said to Moses: **Warn your brother, Aaron, not to enter the Most Holy Place behind the inner curtain whenever he chooses; if he does, he will die.** For the Ark's cover—the place of atonement—is there, and **I myself am present in the cloud above the atonement cover.**

***Ezekiel 28:13-15** You were in Eden, the garden of God. Every kind of precious stone adorned you: ruby, topaz, and diamond, beryl, onyx, and jasper, sapphire, turquoise, and emerald. Your mountings and settings were crafted in gold, prepared on the day of your creation. **14**You were anointed as a guardian cherub, for I had ordained you. **You were on the holy mountain of God;** you walked among the fire stones. **15**From the day you were created you were blameless in your ways—until wickedness was found in you....

***Exodus 33:3** I will not go up in your midst, in case I consume you along the way, for you are a stiff-necked people.

***Leviticus 19:2 (You) BE HOLY FOR I AM HOLY.**

***Psalm 111:9-10** He has sent redemption to His people;

He has commanded His covenant forever:

Holy and awesome is His name. ¹⁰ **The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom;**

A good understanding have all those who do His commandments. His praise endures forever.

***Joshua 24:19-21** But Joshua said to the people, You cannot serve the LORD, for **He is a holy God.** He is a jealous God; He will not forgive your transgressions nor your sins.

20 If you forsake the LORD and serve foreign gods, then He will turn and do you harm and consume you, after He has done you good. **21** And the people said to Joshua, No, but we will serve the LORD!

***1 Samuel 2:2** There is **none holy like the LORD:** for there is **none besides you;** there is **no rock like our God.**

***Hebrews 7:26** For it was indeed fitting that we should have such a high priest, **holy**, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, and exalted above the heavens.

***Mark 1:24** A demon recognizes Yeshua, crying out, "I know who you are—the Holy One of God!"

***Mt 8:28-29** And when he was come to the other side into the country of the Gergesenes, there met him two possessed with devils, coming out of the tombs, exceeding fierce, so that no man might pass by that way.²⁹ And, behold, they cried out, saying, What have we to do with you, Yeshua, you Son of God? are you here to torment us before the time?

***Acts 3:14** Peter preaches to the crowd, stating, "But you denied the Holy and Righteous One, and asked for a murderer to be granted to you.

***Luke 1:35** The angel Gabriel tells Mary, The Holy Spirit will come upon you... therefore the child to be born will be called holy—the Son of God.

***Acts 4:27-30 (selections)** For truly against Your holy Servant Yeshua, whom You anointed,and grant to Your servants that with all boldness that they may speak Your word, by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Yeshua.

***Revelation 3:7** These are the words of him who is holy and true, who holds the key of David. What he opens no one can shut, and what he shuts no one can open.

***Romans 1:3-4** (PAUL WRITES) concerning His Son Yeshua the Messiah, our Lord, who was born of the seed of David according to the flesh, ⁴and declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead.

***Romans 1:2** "...which he promised beforehand through his prophets in the holy Scriptures."

***2 Corinthians 7:1** Therefore, since we have these promises, dear friends, let us purify ourselves from everything that contaminates body and spirit, perfecting holiness out of reverence for God.

***Acts 1:8** But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

***Ezekiel 36:23** I will show the holiness of my great name, which has been profaned among the nations, the name you have profaned among them. Then the nations will know that I am the Lord, declares the Sovereign Lord, when I am proved holy through you before their eyes.

***Hebrews 12:10** Our fathers disciplined us for a short time as they thought best, but God disciplines us for our good, so that we may share in His holiness.

***Matthew 6:9** This, then, is how you should pray: 'Our Father in heaven: May your holy name be honored;

***Romans 8:11** But if the Spirit of Him who raised Yeshua from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Messiah Yeshua from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

***Genesis 36:12** Now Timna was the concubine of Eliphaz, Esau's son, and she bore Amalek to Eliphaz. These were the sons of Adah, Esau's wife.

***Daniel 11:31** Forces will be levied (raised) by him; they will desecrate the temple, the fortress; they will abolish the regular offering and set up the appalling abomination.

***Exodus 17:14** Then God said to Moses, Inscribe this in a document as a reminder, and read it aloud to Joshua: I will utterly blot out the memory of Amalek from under heaven!

***Romans 12:21 DO NOT BE OVERCOME BY EVIL, BUT OVERCOME EVIL WITH GOOD.**
