**Betrayal and the End of Days - Before Our Eyes This Week!**

Nu. 16:1-18:2; 2 Sam. 11:14-12:23.; Matt. 26:13-24

**\*Matthew 26:21** Now as they were eating, He said, Assuredly, I say to you, one of you will betray Me.

**\*II Samuel 11:15&17** And he wrote in the letter, saying, "Set Uriah in the forefront of the hottest battle, and retreat from him, that he may be struck down and die."<sup>17</sup> Then the men of the city came out and fought with Joab. And some of the people of the servants of David fell; and Uriah the Hittite died also.

**2 Timothy 3:1-9** But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: <sup>2</sup>For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, <sup>3</sup>unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, <sup>4</sup>traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, <sup>5</sup>having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away! <sup>6</sup>For of this sort are those who creep into households and make captives of gullible women loaded down with sins, led away by various lusts, <sup>7</sup>always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth. <sup>8</sup>Now as Jannes and Jambres resisted Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, disapproved concerning the faith; <sup>9</sup>but they will progress no further, for their folly will be manifest to all, as theirs also was.

**\*2 Timothy 3:8** Just as Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses, so these men also oppose the truth, men corrupted in mind and disqualified regarding the faith.

**\*Numbers 3:30** And the chief of the house of the father of the families of the Kohathites shall be Elizaphan the son of Uzziel.

**\*Romans 13:1** Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but from God; the powers that be are ordained by God.

**\*Daniel 2:21a** He changes times and seasons; He removes kings and establishes them.

**\*Numbers 16:1-5** <sup>1</sup> Now Korah the son of Izhar, the son of Kohath, the son of Levi, with Dathan and Abiram the sons of Eliab, and On the son of Peleth, sons of Reuben, took men; <sup>2</sup> and

they rose up before Moses with some of the children of Israel, two hundred and fifty leaders of the congregation, representatives of the congregation, men of renown.<sup>3</sup> They gathered together against Moses and Aaron, and said to them, "You take too much upon yourselves, for all the congregation is holy, every one of them, and the Lord is among them. Why then do you exalt yourselves above the assembly of the Lord?"<sup>4</sup> So when Moses heard it, he fell on his face;<sup>5</sup> and he spoke to Korah and all his company, saying, "Tomorrow morning the LORD will show who is His and who is holy, and will cause him to come near to Him. That one whom He chooses He will cause to come near to Him.

**\*Numbers 16:6-11** Do this: Take censers, Korah and all your company;<sup>7</sup> put fire in them and put incense in them before the LORD tomorrow, and it shall be that the man whom the LORD chooses is the holy one. You take too much upon yourselves, you sons of Levi!"<sup>8</sup> Then Moses said to Korah, "Hear now, you sons of Levi:<sup>9</sup> Is it a small thing to you that the God of Israel has separated you from the congregation of Israel, to bring you near to Himself, to do the work of the tabernacle of the LORD, and to stand before the congregation to serve them;<sup>10</sup> and that He has brought you near to Himself, you and all your brethren, the sons of Levi, with you? And are you seeking the priesthood also?<sup>11</sup> Therefore you and all your company are gathered together against the LORD. And what is Aaron that you complain against him?

**\*Numbers 16:19-22** And Korah gathered all the congregation against them at the door of the tabernacle of meeting. Then the glory of the LORD appeared to all the congregation.<sup>20</sup> And the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron, saying,<sup>21</sup> "Separate yourselves from among this congregation, that I may consume them in a moment."<sup>22</sup> Then they fell on their faces, and said, "O God, the God of the spirits of all flesh, shall one man sin, and You be angry with all the congregation?"

**\*Numbers 16:28-32** And Moses said: "By this you shall know that the Lord has sent me to do all these works, for I have not done them of my own will."<sup>29</sup> If these men die naturally like all men, or if they are visited by the common fate of all men, then the LORD has not sent me.<sup>30</sup> But if the LORD creates a new thing, and the earth opens its mouth and swallows them up with all that belongs to them, and they go down alive into the pit, then you will understand that these men have rejected the Lord."<sup>31</sup> Now it came to pass, as he finished speaking all these words, that the ground split apart under them,<sup>32</sup> and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed them up, with their households and all the men with Korah, with all their goods.

**\*Numbers 16:41** On the next day all the congregation of the children of Israel murmured against Moses and Aaron, saying, You have killed the people of the LORD.

**\*Numbers 17:2** Speak to the children of Israel, and get from them a rod from each father's house, all their leaders according to their fathers' houses--twelve rods. Write each

man's name on his rod. <sup>3</sup> And you shall write Aaron's name on the rod of Levi. For there shall be one rod for the head of each father's house.

**\*Numbers 17:8** <sup>8</sup> Now it came to pass on the next day that Moses went into the tabernacle of witness, and behold, the rod of Aaron, of the house of Levi, had sprouted and put forth buds, had produced blossoms and yielded ripe almonds.

**\*Psalm 110:1-2** The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool.<sup>2</sup> The LORD shall send the rod of Your strength out of Zion. Rule in the midst of Your enemies!

**\*Isaiah 11:1** There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse, And a Branch shall grow out of his roots.

**\*Numbers 17:8** <sup>8</sup> Now it came to pass on the next day that Moses went into the tabernacle of witness, and behold, the rod of Aaron, of the house of Levi, had sprouted and put forth buds, had produced blossoms and yielded ripe almonds.

**\*PSALM 2:1-6** Why do the nations conspire and the peoples plot in vain? <sup>2</sup> The kings of the earth rise up and the rulers band together against the Lord and against his anointed, saying, and throw off their shackles."  
<sup>4</sup> The One enthroned in heaven laughs; the Lord scoffs at them. <sup>5</sup> He rebukes them in his anger and terrifies them in his wrath, saying,<sup>6</sup> "I have installed my king on Zion, my holy mountain.

**\*Psalm 121:4** Behold, the Protector of Israel will neither slumber nor sleep. **5** The LORD is your keeper; the LORD is the shade on your right hand.

**\*Numbers 23:9** For from the top of the rocks I see him, And from the hills I behold him; There! A people dwelling alone, Not reckoning itself among the nations.

**Zechariah 12:8-9** On that day the LORD will defend the people of Jerusalem, so that the weakest among them will be like David, and the house of David will be like God, like the angel of the LORD going before them. **9** So on that day I will set out to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem....

**\*Hosea 9:10** I found Israel like grapes in the wilderness; I saw your fathers as the firstripe in the fig tree at her time: but they went to Baalpeor, and separated themselves unto that shame; and their abominations were according as they loved.

**\*Matthew 24:32-35** Now learn this parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near. So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near—at the doors! Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all these things take place.

**\*Matthew 24:13** But he who endures to the end shall be saved.

**\*Isaiah 26:20** Go, my people, enter your rooms and shut your doors behind you. Hide yourselves a little while until the wrath has passed....

**\*Isaiah 26:21** For, behold, the Lord comes out of his place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity: the earth also shall disclose her blood, and shall no more cover her slain.

**\*Genesis 6:13** And God said to Noah, **The end of all flesh** has come before Me, for the earth is filled with violence (HAMAS) through them; and behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

**\*Zephaniah 2:3** Seek God all you humble of the land who have fulfilled god's law; seek righteousness, seek humility. Perhaps you will find shelter on the day of God's anger.

**\*Daniel 11:44-45** But news from the east and the north shall trouble him; therefore he shall go out with great fury to destroy and annihilate many. <sup>45</sup> And he shall plant the tents of his palace between the seas and the glorious holy mountain; yet he shall come to his end, and no one will help him.

**\*Daniel 12:1** In that time, the great prince, Michael, who stands beside the sons of your people, will appear. It will be a time of trouble, the like of which has never been since the nation came into being. At that time, your people will be rescued, all who are found inscribed in the book.

**\*Isaiah 26:19-21** <sup>19</sup> Your dead shall live; Together with my dead body they shall arise. Awake and sing, you who dwell in dust; For your dew is like the dew of herbs, And the earth shall cast out the dead. <sup>20</sup> Come, my people, enter your chambers, And shut your doors behind you; Hide yourself, as it were, for a little moment, Until the indignation is past. <sup>21</sup> For behold, the Lord comes out of His place To punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity; The earth will also disclose her blood, And will no more cover her slain.

**\*Isaiah 34:2** - God's wrath is against all nations and their armies.

**\*Jeremiah 25:32** Disaster spreads from nation to nation like a great storm.

**\*Ezekiel 30:3** The day of the LORD is near, a time of doom for nations.

**\*Haggai 2:7** God will shake all nations before the Desire of All Nations comes.

**\*Matthew 24:7** Nation will rise against nation, accompanied by famines and earthquakes.

**\*Luke 21:26** Men will faint from fear and anxiety **over what is coming upon the earth**, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken.

**\*Revelation 19:7-9a** Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready." <sup>8</sup> And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints.  
<sup>9</sup> Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!
