How Does the War Between The LORD and Satan Involve You Today?

Deut. 3:23-7:11; Isa. 40:1-26; Luke 3:2-15

***Deuteronomy 3:23** And I pleaded with HASHEM at that time, saying, O Lord, You are HASHEM, You have begun to show your servant your greatness and Your hand that is strong, for what power is there in the heavens or in the earth that can do like your deeds and like Your mighty acts?

***Genesis 49:10** The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him shall the gathering (or obedience) of the people be.

***Psalm 72:17** His name shall be forever unto the turning of the sun, his name shall increase and shall be blessed in him all the nations shall call him blessed.

***Jeremiah 16:13** Therefore I will cast you out of this land into a land that you do not know, neither you nor your fathers; and there you shall serve other gods day and night, where I will not show you favor.

***Deuteronomy 3:25-26** I pray, let me cross over and see the good land beyond the Jordan, those pleasant mountains, and Lebanon. **26** But the LORD was angry with me on your account, and would not listen to me. So the LORD said to me: Enough of that! Speak no more to Me of this matter.

***Proverbs 19:21**: Many are the plans in a person's heart, but it is the LORD's purpose that prevails.

***Proverbs 16:9**: In their hearts humans plan their course, but the LORD establishes their steps.

***Isaiah 55:8-9**: For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the LORD.

***Romans 8:28**: And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

***Deuteronomy 3:25** (Moses said) Let me see the land that is good on the other side of the Jordan, the mountain that is good that one, and the Lebanon.

***Deuteronomy 3:27** Go up to the top of the summit, and lift your eyes toward the west, the north, the south, and the east; behold it with your eyes, for you shall not cross over this Jordan.

***Deuteronomy 2:1-4** Then we did what the LORD told me to do. We went back into the desert on the road that leads to the Red Sea. We traveled for many days to go around the mountains of Seir.² Then the LORD said to me,³ 'You have traveled around these mountains long enough. Turn north.⁴ Tell the people this: You will pass through the land of Seir. This land belongs to your relatives, the descendants of Esau. They will be afraid of you. Be very careful.

***Isaiah 43:18-19** Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past. See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland.

***Philippians 3:13** Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead,

***Psalm 121:1-2** I lift up my eyes to the mountains—where does my help come from? My help comes from the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth.

***Acts:1:14** They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers.

***Acts 5:12** The apostles performed many signs and wonders among the people. And all the believers used to meet together in Solomon's Colonnade.

***Acts 2:47** The Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

***Psalm 119:88** Revive me according to Your lovingkindness, so that I may keep the testimony of Your mouth.

***Psalm 119:120** My flesh trembles for fear of you, and I am afraid of your judgments..

***Psalm 147:5** Great is our LORD and abundant in power; his understanding is beyond measure.

***Psalm 27:4** One thing I have asked of the Lord, that will I seek after: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the Lord...

***Proverbs 21:31** The horse is made ready for the day of battle, but the victory belongs to the LORD.

***1 Chronicles 16:2** Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and joy are in his dwelling place.

***I Corinthians 3:11** For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Yeshua the Messiah.

***1 Chronicles 29:11-12** Yours, O LORD, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the victory and the majesty, indeed everything that is in the heavens and the earth; Yours is the dominion, O Lord, and You exalt Yourself as head over all.

***Psalm 10:16** The LORD is king forever and ever; the nations perish from his land.

***II Corinthians 11:14** And no wonder! For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light.

***Deuteronomy 4:27** And the LORD will scatter you among the peoples, and you will be left few in number among the nations where the LORD will drive you.

***1 Corinthians 3:16** Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

***Ephesians 2:21-22** In Him the whole building is fitted together and grows into a holy temple in the Lord. / And in Him you too are being built together into a dwelling place for God in His Spirit.

***I Peter 2:5** you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Yeshua the Messiah.

***1 John 4:4** You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the One who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world.

***I Corinthians 6:14** But he who unites himself with the Lord is one with Him in spirit.

***Genesis 3:5:** Then the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die. For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil. Illustrates his classic tactic of questioning God's commands ("Did God actually say...?")

***James 4:7** Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you".

***Romans 8:37** No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.

***Deuteronomy 6:4-6** Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the LORD is one!
