Leviticus 25:1-27:34; Jeremiah 16:19-17:14; Matthew 16:20-28

***Exodus 40:17** So the tabernacle was set up on the first day of the first month in the second year.

***Leviticus 9:23** Moses and Aaron then went into the tent of meeting. When they came out, they blessed the people; and the glory of the LORD appeared to all the people.

***Numbers 1:1** The LORD spoke to Moses in the tent of meeting in the Desert of Sinai on the first day of the second month of the second year after the Israelites came out of Egypt.....

***Leviticus 25:1** And the LORD spoke to Moses on Mount Sinai, saying,....

***Exodus 20:3** I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.

Isaiah 40:29 He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.

***2 Corinthians 12:9-10** But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.

***Exodus 20:7a** You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God...

***Exodus 20:8-10a** Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work.....

***Exodus 31:17** It is a sign between Me and the Israelites forever; for in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, but on the seventh day He rested and was refreshed.

***Leviticus 25:2-7** Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: **When you come into the land which I give you,** then the **land shall keep a sabbath to the Lord.** Six years you shall sow your field, and six years you shall prune your vineyard, and gather its fruit; but in the **seventh year there shall be a sabbath of solemn rest for the land, a sabbath to the Lord.** You shall neither sow your field nor prune your vineyard. What grows of its own accord of your harvest you shall not reap, nor gather the grapes of your untended vine, for it is a year of rest for the land. And the **sabbath produce of the land shall be food for you: for you, your male and female servants, your hired man, and the stranger who dwells with you, for your livestock and the beasts that are in your land--all its produce shall be for food.**

***Genesis 3:23-24** So the LORD God banished him from the Garden of Eden to work **the ground from which he had been taken.** After **He drove the man out,** He placed on the east side of the Garden of Eden cherubim and a flaming sword flashing back and forth to guard the way to the tree of life.

***Genesis 4:23-24** Lamech said to his wives: "Adah and Zillah, hear my voice; you wives of Lamech, listen to what I say: I have killed a man for wounding me, a young man for striking me. If **Cain's revenge is sevenfold,** then **Lamech's is seventy-sevenfold.**

***Matthew 18:22** Jesus answered, "I tell you, not just seven times, but seventy times seven!

***Numbers 23:9** It is a **nation that dwells alone** and is not reckoned amongst the nations.

***Genesis 2:2** By the seventh day God completed His work which He had done, and He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had done.

2 Peter 3:8 But do not forget this one thing, dear friends: With the Lord **a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day.**

***Revelation 20:1-3** Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven with the key to the Abyss, holding in his hand a great chain. He seized the dragon, that ancient serpent who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years. And threw him into the Abyss, shut it, and sealed it over him, so that he could not deceive the nations until the thousand years were complete. After that, he must be released for a brief period of time....

***HOSEA 6:1,2** Come let us return to the Lord. For He has torn us to pieces, by the will heal us; He has wounded us, but He will bind up our wounds. **After two days He will revive us; on the third day He will raise us up, that we may live in His presence....**

***Leviticus 25:2-5** Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: When you come into the land which I give you, then the land shall keep a sabbath to the Lord.

Six years you shall sow your field, and six years you shall prune your vineyard, and gather its fruit; but in the seventh year there shall be a sabbath of solemn rest for the land, a sabbath to the Lord. You shall neither sow your field nor prune your vineyard. ***2 Chronicles 36:21** Those who escaped the sword were carried by Nebuchadnezzar into exile in Babylon, and they became servants to him and his sons until the kingdom of Persia came to power. So the land enjoyed it 's Sabbath rest all the days of the desolation until seventy years were completed, in fulfillment of the word of the LORD through Jeremiah.

***Leviticus 26:34** Then the land shall enjoy its Sabbaths all the days it lies desolate, while you are in the land of your enemies. At that time the land will rest and enjoy its Sabbaths.

***Hebrews 4:9-11** There remains therefore a rest for the people of God. For he who has entered His rest has himself also ceased from his works as God did from His. **Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience.**

***Hebrews 3:17-19** Now with whom was He angry forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose corpses fell in the wilderness? And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who did not obey? So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.

***Philippians 4:6-7** Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

***Psalm 55:22** Cast your burden on the Lord, and **He will sustain you; He will never permit the righteous to be moved.**

***Deuteronomy 31:6** Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the LORD your God goes with you; **He will never leave you or forsake you.**

***2 Thessalonians 2:4a** He will oppose and will exalt himself over everything that is called God or is worshiped,

***2 Thessalonians 2:9-10** The coming of the lawless one will be in accordance with how Satan works. He will use all sorts of displays of power through signs and wonders that serve the lie, and all the ways that wickedness deceives those who are perishing. They perish **because they refused to love the truth and so be saved.**

***I John 2:18** Dear children, this is the last hour; and as you have heard that the antichrist is coming, even now many antichrists have come. This is how we know it is the last hour.

***I John 2:22** Who is the liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? This is the antichrist, he who denies the Father and the Son.

***1 John 3:4** Everyone who practices sin also practices lawlessness; and sin is lawlessness.

***Leviticus 25:23-24** The land must not be sold permanently because it is Mine, and you are but foreigners and residents with Me. Thus for every piece of property you possess, you must provide for the redemption אֲדָוָה of the land...

***Habakkuk 2:14** For the earth will be **filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD** as the waters cover the sea.

***Leviticus 25:5** What grew on its own עָפְרוֹ of your harvest from seeds of your previous harvest do not harvest. And the grapes you set aside for yourself, do not gather in. A year of rest it shall be for the land.

***Isaiah 14:1** For the LORD will have compassion on Jacob; once again He will choose Israel and settle them in their own land. The foreigner will join וְגֵרֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל them and unite with the house of Jacob.

***John 17:16** They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.

***I Peter 2:11-12** Beloved, I urge you as sojourners and exiles to abstain from the passions of the flesh,

***Genesis 2:7** Then the LORD God formed a man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being.

***I Corinthians 6:19** Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own,

***Exodus 15:2-3** The LORD is my strength and my defense; he has become my salvation. He is my God, and I will praise him, my father's God, and I will exalt him. The LORD is a warrior; the LORD is His name.
