



*Torah Portion Ki Tisa - When You Take  
"Atonement and Awakenings"  
March 2, 2024 - Adar I 22, 5784  
Exodus 30:11-34:35; I Kings 18:1-39; Mark 9:1-10*

**\*Joel 2:31** The sun shall be turned into darkness, And the moon into blood, Before the coming of the great and awesome day of the Lord.

**\*Revelation 6:12** I looked when He opened the sixth seal, and behold, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became like blood.

**\*Exodus 30:11** HASHEM spoke to Moses, saying: When you take a census of the sons of Israel to number them, then each one of them shall give a price of atonement for himself to HASHEM when you number them, **so that there will be no plague among them when you number them.**

**\*Exodus 12:37** The Israelites journeyed from Rameses to Sukkoth. There were about six hundred thousand men on foot, besides women and children.

**\*Exodus 38:26** a beka a head (that is, half a shekel, by the shekel of the sanctuary), for everyone who was listed in the records, from twenty years old and upward, for 603,550 men.

**\*I Chronicles 21:1-2** And Satan stood up against Israel, and provoked David to number Israel. And David said to Joab and to the rulers of the people, Go, number Israel from Beer-sheba even to Dan; and bring the number of them to me, that I may know it.

**\*I Chronicles 21:7-8** And God was displeased with this thing: therefore, He struck Israel. So David said to God, I have sinned greatly, because I have done this thing;

**\*Exodus 30:13-15** This shall they give - everyone who passes through the census (or those who are numbered הַפְּקֻדִים), a half shekel of the shekel of the sanctuary, twenty geras is the shekel, **half a shekel** as a raised-up portion to HASHEM. Everyone who passes through

the census מִפְּקוּדֵי , from the age of twenty years and up shall give the **raised-up** portion of HASHEM. The wealthy one shall not increase and the destitute one shall not decrease from **half a shekel** to give the **raised-up** portion of HASHEM, **to atone for your souls**.

**\*Matthew 27:5-6** So Judas threw **the silver** into the temple and left. Then he went away and hanged himself. And the chief priests, having taken the **pieces of silver**, said, "It is not lawful to put them into the treasury, since **it is the price of blood**."

**\*Colossians 1:14** God's Son, Jesus, **paid the price** for our sins and made us free. Yes, **God has forgiven us**.

**\*I John 2:2** **He is the propitiation for our sins**, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.

**\*Exodus 30:13** ....this they shall give....

**\*Genesis 6:14** Noah covered the ark with pitch inside and outside.

**\*Psalm 78:35-42** And they remembered that God was their rock, and the Most High God their Redeemer. But they deceived Him with their mouth and lied to Him with their tongue. For their heart was not steadfast toward Him, nor were they faithful in His covenant.

But He, being compassionate, כָּפַר **forgave [covered/ransomed/atoned: y'kapper]** their iniquity and did not destroy them; and often He restrained His anger and did not arouse all His wrath. Thus He remembered that they were but flesh, a wind that passes and does not return.

**\*Leviticus 16:32** and the priest shall make **atonement.....**

**\*Colossians 1:14** God's Son, Jesus, **paid the price** for our sins and made us free. Yes, God has forgiven us.

**\*2 Thessalonians 1:7** and give relief to you who are troubled, and to us as well. This will happen when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful angels.

**\*Numbers 11:1** Now the people complained about their hardships in the hearing of the LORD, and when he heard them his anger was aroused. Then fire from the LORD burned among them and **consumed some of the outskirts** בְּקִצְהָ of the camp.

**\*Joshua 9:16** And it happened **at the end** מִקְצֵה of three days, after they had made a covenant with them, that they heard that they were their neighbors who dwelt near them.

**\*Deuteronomy 5:24** And you said, The LORD our God has shown us his glory and his majesty, and we have heard his voice from the fire.

**\*Luke 3:16** John answered them all, I baptize you with water. But one who is more powerful than I will come, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.

**\*Proverbs 12:28** In the pathway of righteousness there is life  
And

**\*Proverbs 11:4** but righteousness will rescue from death.

**\*Matthew 9:4-6** But Yeshua knew what they were thinking and said, Why do you harbor evil in your hearts? Which is easier: to say, Your sins are forgiven, or to say, Get up and walk? But so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins... Then He said to the paralytic, Get up, pick up your mat, and go home.

**\*Exodus 31:1-3** Then the LORD said to Moses, See, I have chosen Bezalel son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah, and I have filled him with the Spirit of God, with wisdom, with understanding, with knowledge and with all kinds of skills.

**\*Job 32:8** The breath of the Almighty gives him [man] understanding.

**\*Genesis 1:2** The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

**\*Matthew 7:24** Everyone then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock.

**\*Exodus 36:1** So Bezalel, Oholiab, and every skilled person will do the work the LORD has commanded, because he gave them the wisdom and understanding to do all the skilled work needed to build the Holy Tent.

**\*Exodus 32:7-8** And the Lord said to Moses, Go, get down! For your people whom you brought out of the land of Egypt have corrupted themselves. They have turned aside quickly out of the way which I commanded them. They have made themselves a molded calf, and worshiped it and sacrificed to it, and said, This is your god, O Israel, that brought you out of the land of Egypt!

**\*Exodus 32:10** And now, release Me, and flare up shall My anger against them and I shall annihilate them; and I shall make you into a nation that is great.

**\*Exodus 32:19** As Moses approached the camp and saw the calf and the dancing, he burned with anger and threw the tablets out of his hands, shattering them at the base of the mountain.

**\*Exodus 34:1** Carve out two stone tablets like the first ones, and I will write on them the words that were on the first tablets which you broke.

**\*Exodus 17:9** Choose men and go out and fight the Amalekites...

**\*1 Corinthians 3:9** For we are God's fellow workers;

**\*John 5:17** Jesus said to them, My Father is continuing to work and I am working.

**\*Ephesians 3:7** of which I was made a minister, according to the gift of God's grace which was given to me according to the working of His power.

**\*Ephesians 2:10** For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.

**\*1 Corinthians 15:10** But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me did not prove vain; but I labored even more than all of them, yet not I, but the grace of God with me.

**\*John 15:5** "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.

**\*John 1:12** Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God.

**\*Jeremiah 3:33** Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.

**\*Isaiah 33:6a** He will be the sure foundation for your times, a storehouse of salvation, wisdom, and knowledge.

**\*Hebrews 6:19** This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast. It enters the inner sanctuary behind the curtain, where Jesus our forerunner has entered on our behalf.

**\*Luke 6:48** They are like a man building a house, who dug down deep and laid the foundation on rock. When a flood came, the torrent struck that house but could not shake it, because it was well built.

**\*Jeremiah 29:13** You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.

**\*1 Corinthians 3:11** For man can lay no other foundation, than that which is Jesus Christ.

**\*John 10:27-30** My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand. I and my Father are one.

**\*John 14:15** If you love me, keep my commands.
