



Torah Portion Lech Lecha - Go - It's Time to Leave Babylon

October 28, 2023 - Chesvan 13, 5784

Genesis 12:1-17:27; Isaiah 40:27-41:16; John 8:51-58

***Genesis 7:11** In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, on that day all the fountains of the great deep were broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened.

***Genesis 9:28-29** And Noah lived after the flood three hundred and fifty years. So all the days of Noah were nine hundred and fifty years; and he died.

***Genesis 25:7** This is the sum of the years of Abraham's life which he lived: **one hundred and seventy-five years.**

***Malachi 3:6** For **I the Lord do not change**; therefore you, O children of Jacob, are not consumed.

***Psalm 119:8** Forever, O Lord, your word is firmly fixed in the heavens.

***Genesis 6:9** This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was a just man, perfect in his generations. Noah walked with Elohim.

***Genesis 12:1** Now the LORD had said to Abram: **Get out of your country, from your family and from your father's house,** to a land that I will show you.

***Mark 3:35** For **whoever does the will of God,** he is My brother and sister and mother.

***Galatians 3:26** So **in Yeshua HaMashiach you are all children of God through faith,**

***Romans 8:15-16 ... rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father." The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children**

***Isaiah 43:6-7** Bring my sons from afar and my daughters from the ends of the earth—everyone who is called by my name, whom I created for my glory, whom I formed and made."

***Psalm 34:10** The lions may grow weak and hungry, but those who seek the LORD lack no good thing.

***Genesis 15:7** Abram believed the LORD, and he credited it to him as righteousness. He also said to him, I am the LORD, who brought you out of Ur of the Chaldeans to give you this land to take possession of it.

***Genesis 10:10** The beginning of his (Nimrod's) kingdom was Babel and Erech and Accad and Calneh, in the land of Shinar [in Babylonia].

***Isaiah 47:1-3** Come down and sit in the dust, O virgin daughter of Babylon; sit on the ground without a throne, O daughter of the Chaldeans (ANOTHER WORD FOR BABYLONIANS)! For you shall no more be called tender and delicate. Take the millstones and grind meal. Remove your veil, take off the skirt, uncover the thigh, pass through the rivers. Your nakedness shall be uncovered, yes, your shame will be seen; I will take vengeance, and I will not arbitrate with a man.

***Isaiah 52:1-2** Awake, awake! Put on your strength, O Zion; put on your beautiful garments[righteousness], O Jerusalem, the holy city! For the uncircumcised and the unclean shall no longer come to you. **Shake yourself** from the dust, arise; Sit down, O Jerusalem! **Loose yourself** from the bonds of your neck, O captive daughter of Zion!

***Isaiah 52:11-12** Depart! Depart! Go out from there, touch no unclean thing; go out from the midst of her, be clean, you who bear the vessels of Adonai. For you shall not go out with haste, nor go by flight; for Adonai will go before you, and the the God of Israel will be your rear guard.

***Exodus 20:1-2** And God spoke all these words, saying: I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. You shall have no other elohim before [besides, except, but] Me.

***Ephesians 3:20-21** Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, to Him be glory in the ecclesia by Messiah Yeshua to all generations, forever and ever.

***2 Corinthians 6:14-18** Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? And what accord has Messiah with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever? And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? **For ye are the temple of the living God. As God has said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.** Wherefore **come out from among them, and be separate, says the LORD.** Touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, and will be a Father to you, and you shall be my sons and daughters, says the LORD Almighty.

***Joshua 24:14-15** Now therefore, fear the LORD, serve Him in sincerity and in truth, and put away the elohim (the gods, the law makers and the judges) which your fathers served on the other side of the River and in Egypt. Serve the LORD! And if it seems evil to you to serve the LORD, choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the elohim which your fathers served that were on the other side of the River, or the elohim of the Amorites, in whose land you dwell. **But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.**

***Jeremiah 51:53** Though Babylon should ascend to the heavens, And though she should fortify her lofty stronghold,
From Me destroyers will come to her, declares the Lord.

***Isaiah 21:9** Look, riders come—horsemen in pairs. And he answered, saying, **Babylon has fallen, has fallen.** All the images of her gods have been shattered on the ground.

***Revelation 14:8** And another angel, a second one, followed, saying, Fallen, fallen is Babylon the great, she who has made all the nations drink of the wine of the passion of her immorality.

***Revelation 17:3-6** So he carried me away in the Spirit into the wilderness. And I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast *which was full of names of blasphemy*, having seven heads and ten horns. The woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet, and adorned with gold and precious stones and pearls, having in her hand a golden cup full of abominations and the filthiness of her fornication. And on her forehead a name was written:

MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT,
THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS
AND OF THE ABOMINATIONS
OF THE EARTH.

I saw the woman, drunk with the blood of the saints and with the blood of the martyrs of Yeshua. And when I saw her, I marveled with great amazement.

***Isaiah 9:11** The bricks have fallen, but we will rebuild with finished stone; the sycamores have been felled, but we will replace them with cedars.

***Isaiah 26:20** Go, my people, enter your rooms and shut the doors behind you; hide yourselves for a little while until his wrath has passed by.

***Genesis 12:1** Now the LORD said to Abram: Get out of your country, from your family and from your father's house, to a land that I will show you.

***Ephesians 6:11** Put on the whole armor of God that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

***Matthew 4:3-4** Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread. But He answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.

***Joshua 1:7-9** Above all, be strong and very courageous. Be careful to observe all the law that My servant Moses commanded you. Do not turn from it to the right or to the left, so that you may prosper wherever you go. This Book of the Law

must not depart from your mouth; **meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it.** Have I not commanded you to be strong and courageous? **Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged,** for the **LORD your God is with you wherever you go.**

***2 Corinthians 10:4** For **the weapons of our warfare** are not carnal but **mighty in God** for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and **every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God,** bringing **every thought** into captivity to the obedience of Christ,

***I Thessalonians 1:5** For when we brought you the Good News; it was **not only with words but also with power,** for the **Holy Spirit gave you full assurance that what we said was true.**

***I Peter 1:22a-23** Seeing you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit ... Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, **by the word of God, which lives and abides forever.**

***Philippians 3:20-21** **But we are citizens of heaven,** where the Lord Jesus Christ lives. And we are eagerly waiting for Him to return as our Savior. He will take our weak mortal bodies and change them into glorious bodies like his own, using the same power with which he will bring everything under his control.

***Genesis 12:2-3** **I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great;** and **you shall be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you,** and **I will curse him who curses you;** and **in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.**

***Ephesians 2:12-13** **remember that at that time you were separate from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world.** But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ....

***Psalm 121:2-5** **My help comes from the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth.** Indeed, **He who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep.** The sun will not harm you by day, nor the moon by night. **The LORD will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.**
