



*Torah Portion Metzarah - Spiritual Warfare Part 4*  
*April 20, 2024;; Nisan 12, 5784*  
*Leviticus 14:1-15:33; Malachi 3:4-24(4:6); Matthew 17:9-13*

**\*Matthew 13:16-17** But blessed are your eyes because they see, and your ears because they hear. For truly, I say to you, many prophets and righteous people longed to see what you see, and did not see it, and to hear what you hear, and did not hear it.

**\*Matthew 15:24** But He answered and said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel."

**\*Romans 15:8** For I tell you that Messiah has become a servant of the circumcised on behalf of God's truth, to confirm the promises made to the patriarchs,

**\*Isaiah 41:8** But you, Israel, My servant, Jacob whom I have chosen, Seed of Abraham My friend,...

**\*Isaiah 52:13-14** Behold, My Servant will prosper; He will be raised and lifted up and highly exalted. Just as many were appalled at Him—His appearance was disfigured beyond that of any man, and His form was marred beyond human likeness—

**\*Genesis 3:15** And I will put enmity between your and the woman and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head and you shall bruise His heel.

**\*Genesis 12:3** I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you.

**\*John 10:10** The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

**\*Revelation 12:9** And the great dragon was hurled down—that ancient serpent called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world. He was hurled to the earth, and his angels with him.

**\*2 Corinthians 3:16-18** But when one turns to the Lord, the veil is removed. Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same

image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.

**\*Ephesians 6:12** Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.

**\*John 12:31** Now judgment is upon this world; now the prince of this world will be cast out.

**\*Revelation 13:8-9** And all who dwell on the earth will worship the beast—all whose names have not been written from the foundation of the world in the Book of Life belonging to the Lamb who was slain. All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

**\*Psalm 2:7** I will declare the decree: The LORD has said to Me, 'You are My Son, Today I have begotten You.

**\*Leviticus 14:1** Then the LORD spoke to Moses saying, This shall be the law of the leper for the day of his cleansing; He shall be brought to the priest.

**\*Romans 11:23** And if they do not persist in unbelief, they will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again.

**\*Isaiah 11:11** It shall come to pass in that day, that the Lord shall set His hand again the second time to recover the remnant of His people who are left, From Assyria and Egypt, From Pathros and Cush, From Elam and Shinar, From Hamath and the islands of the sea. He will set up a banner for the nations, and will assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

**\*Leviticus 14:33-34, 36a** And the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron, saying: When you have come into the land of Canaan, which I give you as a possession, and I put the leprous plague in a house in the land of your possession,.....then the priest shall command that they empty the house,.....

**\*Leviticus 15:44-45** Now if the plague comes back and breaks out in the house, after he has taken away the stones, after he has scraped the house, and after it is plastered, then the priest shall come and look; and indeed if the plague has spread in the house, it is an active leprosy in the house. It is unclean. And he shall break down the house, its stones,

its timber, and all the plaster of the house, and he shall carry them outside the city to an unclean place.

**\*Luke 17:30-31** It will be just like that on the day the Son of Man is revealed. **On that day**, let no one on the housetop come down (into the house) to retrieve his possessions. Likewise, let no one in the field return for anything he has left behind.

### **(Luke 17:11-36) Ten Lepers Cleansed**

<sup>11</sup> Now it happened as He went to Jerusalem that He passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee. <sup>12</sup> Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off. <sup>13</sup> And they lifted up *their* voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!"

<sup>14</sup> So when He saw *them*, He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed.

<sup>15</sup> And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, <sup>16</sup> and fell down on *his* face at His feet, giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan.

<sup>17</sup> So Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where *are* the nine? <sup>18</sup> Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" <sup>19</sup> And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well."

### **The Coming of the Kingdom**

<sup>20</sup> Now when He was asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, "The kingdom of God does not come with observation; <sup>21</sup> nor will they say, 'See here!' or 'See there!' For indeed, the kingdom of God is within you."

<sup>22</sup> Then He said to the disciples, "The days will come when you will desire to see one of the days of the Son of Man, and you will not see *it*. <sup>23</sup> And they will say to you, 'Look here!' or 'Look there!' Do not go after *them* or follow *them*. <sup>24</sup> For as the lightning that flashes out of one *part* under heaven shines to the other *part* under heaven, so also the Son of Man will be in His day. <sup>25</sup> But first He must suffer many things and be rejected by this generation. <sup>26</sup> And as it was in the days of Noah, so it will be also in the days of the Son of Man: <sup>27</sup> They ate, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and the flood came and destroyed them all. <sup>28</sup> Likewise as it was also in the days of Lot: They ate, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they built; <sup>29</sup> but on the day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and

brimstone from heaven and destroyed *them* all. <sup>30</sup> Even so will it be in the day when the Son of Man is revealed.

<sup>31</sup> "In that day, he who is on the housetop, and his goods *are* in the house, let him not come down to take them away. And likewise the one who is in the field, let him not turn back.<sup>32</sup> Remember Lot's wife. <sup>33</sup> Whoever seeks to save his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life will preserve it. <sup>34</sup> I tell you, in that night there will be two *men* in one bed: the one will be taken and the other will be left. <sup>35</sup> Two *women* will be grinding together: the one will be taken and the other left. <sup>36</sup> Two *men* will be in the field: the one will be taken and the other left."

**\*Revelation 12:5-6** And she gave birth to a son, a male child, who will rule all the nations with an iron scepter. And her child was caught up to God and to His throne.

**6** And the woman fled into the wilderness, where God had prepared a place for her to be nourished for 1,260 days....

**\*Isaiah 11:11-12** It shall come to pass in that day, that the Lord shall set His hand again the second time to recover the remnant of His people who are left, From Assyria and Egypt, From Pathros and Cush, From Elam and Shinar, From Hamath and the islands of the sea.

**\*Genesis 36:15** These were dukes (or chiefs) of the sons of Esau: the sons of Eliphaz the firstborn son of Esau; duke Teman, duke Omar, duke Zepho, duke Kenaz,....

**\*Amos 1:11** For three transgressions of Edom, and for four, I will not turn away its punishment, because he pursued his brother with the sword and cast off all pity; his anger tore perpetually, and he kept his wrath forever.

**\*Deuteronomy 25:17-19** Remember what the Amalekites did to you along your way from Egypt; how they met you on your journey when you were tired and weary, and they attacked all your stragglers; they had no fear of God....

When the LORD your God gives you rest from the enemies around you in the land that He is giving you to possess as an inheritance, **you are to blot out the memory of Amalek from under heaven. Do not forget!**

**\*Jeremiah 49:7** Against Edom. Thus says the LORD of hosts: Is wisdom no more in Teman (Yemen)? Has counsel perished from the prudent? Has their wisdom vanished?

**\*Jeremiah 49:8&10** Turn and run! Lie low, O dwellers of Dedan, for **I will bring disaster on Esau** at the time I punish him. .... But **I will strip Esau bare; I will uncover** his hiding places, and he will be unable to conceal himself. **His descendants will be destroyed along with his relatives and neighbors, and he will be no more....**

**\*Amos 1:11-13** This is what the LORD says: "For three transgressions of Edom, even four, I will not revoke My judgment, **because he pursued his brother with the sword and stifled all compassion; his anger raged continually, and his fury flamed incessantly.** So **I will send fire upon Teman(Yemen)** to devour the palaces of Bozrah. This is what the LORD says: "For three transgressions of the Ammonites, even four, I will not revoke My judgment, because they ripped open the pregnant women of Gilead in order to enlarge their territory....

**\*Ezekiel 38:3-6; 8,15,16,** and say, 'Thus says the Lord God: "Behold, I am against you, O Gog, the prince of Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal. <sup>4</sup> I will turn you around, put hooks into your jaws, and lead you out, with all your army, horses, and horsemen, all splendidly clothed, a great company with bucklers and shields, all of them handling swords. <sup>5</sup> Persia, Ethiopia, and Libya are with them, all of them with shield and helmet; <sup>6</sup> Gomer and all its troops; the house of Togarmah from the far north and all its troops--many people are with you.

**In the latter years you will come into the land of those brought back from the sword and gathered from many people on the mountains of Israel, which had long been desolate; they were brought out of the nations, and now all of them dwell safely.**

Then you will come from your place out of the far north, you and many peoples with you, all of them riding on horses, a great company and a mighty army. <sup>16</sup> You will come up against My people Israel like a cloud, to cover the land. It will be in the latter days that **I will bring you against My land, so that the nations may know Me, when I am sanctified in you,** O Gog, before their eyes.

**\*Obadiah 1:18** Then the house of Jacob will be a blazing fire, and the house of Joseph a burning flame; but the house of Esau will be stubble—Jacob will set it ablaze and consume it. Therefore, **no survivor will remain from the house of Esau.** For the LORD has spoken.

**\*Jeremiah 49:20** Therefore, hear **the plans that the LORD has drawn up against Edom and the strategies He has devised against the people of Teman(Yemen):** Surely the little ones of the flock will be dragged away; certainly their pasture will be made desolate because of them.

**\*Matthew 24:32-34** Now learn this parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near. So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near—at the doors! Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all these things take place.
