Exodus 1:1-6:1; Isaiah 27:6-28:13; Matthew 2:1-12

***Genesis 46:8** Now these are the names of the children of Israel who were coming to Egypt....

THIS VERSE INTRODUCES THE EXILE.

***Exodus 1:1** And these are the names of the children of Israel who were coming to Egypt;

Reuben/"See, a Son" ***Isaiah 9:6** For unto us a son is born...

Simeon/"Hearing" ***Luke 9:35** This is My beloved Son, hear Him.

Levi/"Joined/my heart" ***Ehp.2:13b...** brought near by the blood of the Messiah
Judah/"Praise" ***2Cor. 5:17** Therefore, if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature.

Dan/"Judgment" ***John 16:33b ...** not be judged but has crossed over from death to life

Naphtali/"Wrestling" ***I Tim. 6:12** Fight the good fight of faith,...

Gad/"Troop, Company" ***Galatians 6:2a** Bear one another's burdens

Issachar/"Hire" ***II Peter 1:11** make every effort to confirm your calling....

Zebulun/"Dwelling, Exalt, Honor" **I Cor. 6:20** You were bought with a price; Therefore glorify

Joseph/"Adding" **Matthew 28:18** Go therefore and make disciples of all nations

Asher/ "Happy, Blessed" **Psalm 144:15** Happy are the people whose God is the Lord

Benjamin/"Son of My Right Hand" ***Acts 7:56** Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God.

Exodus 1:5,6 And it was that all the souls that issued from the loins of Jacob were seventy souls and Joseph was in Egypt. Joseph died, and all his brothers and all of that generation.

***Genesis 2:7** And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul (nephesh).

***Proverbs 27:7** says, A satisfied soul loathes the honeycomb.

***Deuteronomy 6:5** You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul (nephesh) and with all your might.

The New Testament reiterates this commandment:

***Matthew 22:37** (TPT) Love the Lord your God with every passion of your heart, with all the energy of your being, and with every thought that is within you.,

***Matthew 22:37** And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.

***Psalm 49:7,8** No one can redeem the life of another or give to God a ransom for them [the ransom for a nephesh is costly, no payment is ever enough] so that they אֲשֶׁר should live on forever and not see decay

***Psalm 49:15** But God will redeem my soul (nephesh) from the power of the grave; for He shall receive me.

***Exodus 1:8-11a** Now there arose a new king over Egypt, who did not know Joseph. And he said to his people, "Look, the people of the children of Israel are more and mightier than we; come, let us deal shrewdly with them, lest they multiply, and it happen, in the event of war, that they also join our enemies and fight against us, and so go up out of the land." Therefore, they set taskmasters over them to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for Pharaoh supply cities, Pithom and Raamses.

***Exodus 2:22** And Pharaoh commanded all his people, saying, Every son who is born you shall cast into the river and every daughter you shall save alive.

***Exodus 2:5-8** Then the daughter of Pharaoh came down to bathe at the river. And her maidens walked along the riverside; and when she saw the ark among the reeds, she sent her maid to get it. And when she opened it, she saw the child, and behold, the baby wept. So she had compassion on him, and said, "This is one of the Hebrews' children." Then his sister said to Pharaoh's daughter, "Shall I go and call a nurse for you from the Hebrew women, that she may nurse the child for you?" And Pharaoh's daughter said to her, "Go." So the maiden went and called the child's mother.

***I Chronicles 4:18** And his wife Jehudijah bare Jered the father of Gedor, and Heber the father of Socho, and Jekuthiel the father of Zanoah. And these are the sons of Bithiah the daughter of Pharaoh, which Mered took.

***Exodus 2:9** Then Pharaoh's daughter said to her, Take this child away and nurse him for me, and I will give you your wages. So the woman took the child and nursed him.

***Exodus 2:10** And the child grew, and she brought him to Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. So she called his name Moses, saying, Because I drew him out of the water.

***Exodus 2:11-15** Now it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out to his brethren and looked at their burdens. And he saw an Egyptian beating a Hebrew, one of his brethren. So he looked this way and that way, and when he saw no one, he killed the Egyptian and hid him in the sand. And when he went out the second day, behold, two Hebrew men were fighting, and he said to the one who did the wrong, "Why are you striking your companion?" Then he said, "Who made you a prince and a judge over us? Do you intend to kill me as you killed the Egyptian?" So Moses feared and said, "Surely this thing is known!" When Pharaoh heard of this matter, he sought to kill Moses. **But Moses fled** from the face of Pharaoh and dwelt in the land of Midian; and he sat down by a well.

***Exodus 2:16,17** Now the priest of Midian had seven daughters: and they came and drew water, and filled the troughs to water their father's flock. And the shepherds came and drove them away: but Moses stood up and helped them, and watered their flock.

***Exodus 2:18-22** When they came to Reuel their father he said, How is it that you have come so soon today? And they said, An Egyptian delivered us from the hand of the shepherds, and he also drew enough water for us and watered the flock. So he said to his daughters, And where is he? Call him, that he may eat bread. Then Moses was content to live with the man, and he gave Zipporah his daughter to Moses. And she bore him a son. He called his name Gershom, for he said, I have been a stranger in a foreign land.

***Exodus 2:23** Now it happened in the process of time that the king of Egypt died. Then the children of Israel groaned because of the bondage and they cried out; and their cry came up to God because of the bondage.

***Exodus 2:24,25** So God heard their groaning, and God remembered His covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob. And God looked upon the children of Israel, and God acknowledged them.

***Exodus 3:1-6** Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian. And he led the flock to the back of the desert, and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. And the Angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire from the midst of a bush. So he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, but the bush was not consumed. Then Moses said, "I will now turn aside and see this great sight, why the bush does not burn." So when the LORD saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am." Then He said, "Do not draw near this place. Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground." Moreover He said, "I am the God of your father—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob." And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look upon God.

***Deuteronomy 33:16a** with the choice gifts of the land and everything in it, and with the favor of Him who dwelt in the burning bush.

***Psalm 34:17** When the righteous cry for help, the Lord hears, and rescues them from all their troubles

***Matthew 28:20** And behold, I am always with you, to the end of the age.

***Psalm 145:18** The Lord is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth.

***John 16:33** These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

***Matthew 27:28,29** "They stripped him and put a scarlet robe on him, and then twisted together a crown of thorns and set it on his head.

***Exodus 3:7,8a** I have indeed seen the suffering of My people that is in Egypt, and the outcry I have heard that resulted from the acts of their slave drivers, for I have known of their pain. I have descended to rescue them.....

2 Timothy 4:17 But the Lord stood by me and strengthened me; that through me the message might be fully proclaimed, and that all the Gentiles might hear: and I was delivered out of the mouth of the lion.
