



## Congregation Notes: TAZRIA-METZORA

APRIL 22, 2023 - NISAN 22, 5783

Leviticus 12:1 - 15:33; Isaiah 66:1-24; Mark 9:40-50

**\*Leviticus 12:2** Speak to the children of Israel, saying: If a woman has conceived, and borne a male child, then she shall be unclean seven days, as in the days of her customary impurity she shall be unclean.

**\*Leviticus 19:16** Do not go about spreading slander among your people. Do not do anything that endangers your neighbor's life. I am the LORD.

**\*Leviticus 22:2-4** Tell Aaron and his sons to be careful with the holy gifts of the sons of Israel, which they dedicate to Me, so as not to profane My holy name; I am the Lord. Say to them, 'If any man among all your descendants throughout your generations approaches the holy gifts which the sons of Israel dedicate to the Lord, while he has an uncleanness, that person shall be cut off from before Me; I am the Lord. No man of the descendants of Aaron, who is a leper or who has a discharge, may eat of the holy gifts until he is clean. And if one touches anything made unclean by a corpse or if a man has a seminal emission,.....

**\*Genesis 3:8** They heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden.

**\*Genesis 2:19** In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread till you return to the ground. For out of it you were taken; for dust you are, and to dust you shall return.

**\*2 Samuel 14:14** All of us must die eventually. Our lives are like water spilled out on the ground, which cannot be gathered up again. But God does not just sweep life away; instead, he devises ways to bring us back when we have been separated from him.

**\*Matthew 22:32** I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living.

**\*John 3:16** For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

**\*Genesis 3:15** And I will put enmity between you and the woman and between your seed and her Seed.....

**\*Leviticus 12:1-2** Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the children of Israel, saying: If a woman has conceived, and borne a male child, then she shall be unclean seven days; as in the days of her customary impurity she shall be unclean.

**\*Psalm 2:7-8** I will declare unto the decree, Yahweh (the LORD) has said to me: You are My Son, today I have begotten You. ( יְלֵדָתִי )

**\*Isaiah 37:3** And they said to him, thus says Hezekiah a day of trouble and rebuke and blasphemy is this for the sons have come to birth, but there is no strength to bring them\*

**Luke 1:26-38** In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a village of Galil named Natzeret, to a virgin engaged to a man whose name was Yoseph, of the house of David. And the virgin's name was Maryam. When he came to her and said, "Greetings, exceedingly favored one, the LORD is with you!" But she was deeply distressed by this blessing and wondered what this greeting could mean. Then the angel said to her, "Have no fear Maryam, for you have found favor before God. Listen you shall conceive and give birth to a son. You must call His name Yeshua. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. And the Lord God will give to him the throne of his father David, and he will reign over the house of Yaakov forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end."

Then Maryam said to the angel, "How can this be, since I am a virgin?" And the angel answered her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; hence, the Child born to you will be called

**\*Isaiah 9:6** For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

**\*Matthew 1:1** The scroll recording the family ancestry of Yeshua the Anointed One, son of David, son of Avarham.

**\*Leviticus 12:3** And on the eighth day the flesh of his foreskin shall be circumcised.

**\*Luke 2:21** When eight days had passed, the time arrived for His circumcision, He was named Yeshua, the name given to Him by the angel before He was conceived in the womb.

**\*John 8:12** Then Yeshua again spoke to them teaching, I am the light of the world. The person who follows Me will not walk in the darkness but will have the light of life.

**\*Leviticus 12:6a** When the days of her purification are fulfilled, whether for a son or a daughter, she shall bring to the priest a lamb of the first year.....

**\*John 1:29** The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and \*said, Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of world!

**\*Revelation 17:14** These will wage war against the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, because He is Lord of lords and King of kings, and those who are with Him are the called and chosen and faithful.

**\*Luke 2:22** Then the time came for their purification according the Torah of Moses. They took Him to Yerushalayim to present Him to the LORD.

**\*Exodus 13:2,12) 2:24** As it is written in the Torah of the LORD, every male that opens the womb will be called holy to the LORD....

**\*Acts 4:30** And stretch your hand for healing and for mighty acts and for signs to occur in the name of your Holy Son Yeshua.

**\*Leviticus 12:8** and to offer sacrifice according of what is prescribed in the Torah of the LORD, A pair of turtle doves or two young pigeons.

**\*Luke 2:24** They also offered a sacrifice. They did it in keeping with the law, which says, a pair of doves or two young pigeons.

**\*Leviticus 14:1-2** And the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron saying: This shall be the law of the leper for the day of his cleansing. He shall be brought to the priest.

**\*John 18:19,28-38a** The high priest questioned Jesus about his followers and his teaching.....Jesus was taken from Caiaphas to the building where the Roman governor stayed. But the crowd waited outside. Any of them who had gone inside would have become unclean and would not be allowed to eat the Passover meal. Pilate came out and asked, "What charges are you bringing against this man?" They answered, "He is a criminal! That's why we brought him to you." Pilate told them, "Take him and judge him by your own laws." The crowd replied, "We are not allowed to put anyone to death." And so what Jesus said about his death would soon come true. Pilate then went back inside. He called Jesus over and asked, "Are you the king of the Jews?" Jesus answered, "Are you asking this on your own or did someone tell you about me?" "You know I'm not a Jew!" Pilate said. "Your own people and the chief priests brought You to me. What have you done?" Jesus answered, "My kingdom doesn't belong to this world. If it did, my followers would have fought to keep me from being handed over to our leaders. No, my kingdom doesn't belong to this world." "So you are a king," Pilate replied. "You are saying that I am a king,"

Jesus told him. "I was born into this world to tell about the truth. And everyone who belongs to the truth knows my voice." Pilate asked Jesus, "What is truth?"

**\*John 12:24** In solemn truth I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone. If it dies, however, it produces much fruit.

**\*Matthew 13:37** And He said, The one who sows the good seed is the Son of Man,

**\*Mark 4:26** And He was saying, the kingdom of God is like a man who casts seed upon the soil;

**\*Revelation 12:1-2** And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars: and she, being with child cried, travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered.

**\*Revelation 12:5** She bore a male Child who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron. And her Child was caught up to God and His throne.

**\*Revelation 12:10,11** Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

**\*Revelation 12:13** Now when the dragon saw that he had been cast to the earth, he persecuted the woman who gave birth to the male Child.

**\*Revelation 12:15-17** So the serpent spewed water out of his mouth like a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away by the flood. But the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed up the flood which the dragon had spewed out of his mouth. And the dragon was enraged with the woman, and he went to make war with the rest of her offspring, who keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

**\*Luke 23:13-21&24** Pilate called together the chief priests, the rulers and the people, and said to them, "You brought me this man as one who was inciting the people to rebellion. I have examined him in your presence and have found no basis for your charges against him. Neither has Herod, for he sent him back to us; as you can see, he has done nothing to deserve death. Therefore, I will punish him and then release him." But the whole crowd shouted, "Away with this man! Release Barabbas to us!" (Barabbas had been thrown into prison for an insurrection in the city, and for murder.) Wanting to release Jesus, Pilate appealed to them again. But they kept shouting, "Crucify him! Crucify him!".... So Pilate gave sentence that it should be as they requested.

**\*Leviticus 14:1-2** And the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron, saying: This shall be the law of the leper for the day of his cleansing: He shall be brought to the priest.

**\*Exodus 19:6** And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. These are the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel.

**\*Hebrews 13:12-13** And so Jesus also suffered outside the city gate to make the people holy through his own blood. Let us, then, go to him outside the camp, bearing the disgrace that he bore.

**\*Isaiah 53:4** Surely he has borne our sickness and carried our suffering; yet we considered him plagued, struck by God, and afflicted.

**\*Zechariah 10:6&8** I will strengthen the house of Judah,  
And I will save the house of Joseph. I will bring them back, Because I have mercy on them. They shall be as though I had not cast them aside; For I am the Lord their God, And I will hear them. I will whistle for them and gather them, For I will redeem them; And they shall increase as they once increased.

**\*Zechariah 12:10-11** And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn. In that day there shall be a great mourning in Jerusalem, like the mourning at Hadad Rimmon in the plain of Megiddo.

**Zechariah 13:1-2** On that day a fountain will be opened for the house of David and for the residents of Jerusalem, to wash away sin and impurity. It shall be in that day," says the LORD of hosts, "that I will cut off the names of the idols from the land, and they shall no longer be remembered. I will also cause the prophets and the unclean spirit to depart from the land.

**\*Zechariah 14:4a** And in that day His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, which faces Jerusalem on the east and the Mount of Olives shall be split in two, from east to west.....

**\*Zechariah 14:8a-9** And in that day it shall be that living waters shall flow from Jerusalem, And the LORD shall be King over all the earth. In that day it shall be the LORD is one and His name one.

**\*Revelation 22:20** He who testifies to these things says, Surely, I am coming quickly, Amen, Even so come, Lord Jesus! The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all Amen.
