



Torah Portion Tetzaveh

March 4, 2023 - Adar 11, 5783

Exodus 27:20-30:10; I Samuel 15:2-34; Mark 6:14-29

***Exodus 32:31-33** So Moses returned to the LORD and said, Oh, what a great sin these people have committed! They have made gods of gold for themselves. Yet now, If You would only forgive their sin.... But if not, please blot me out of the book that You have written. The LORD replied to Moses, whoever has sinned against Me, I will blot out of My book.

***Romans 9:3** For I could wish that I myself were accursed, cut off from Christ, for the sake of my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh.

***John 10:11** I am the good shepherd; the good shepherd lays down His life for the sheep.

***1 John 3:16** This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters.

***1 Corinthians 13:13** Three things will last forever--faith, hope, and love--and the greatest of these is love.

***Exodus 27:20** And you shall command the Children of Israel that they shall bring to you olive oil that is clear, crushed, for illumination, to light a lamp continually.

***Isaiah 53:7** He was beaten, He was tortured, but He didn't say a word. Like a lamb taken to be slaughtered and like a sheep being sheared, He took it all in silence.

***John 8:12** I am the light of the world. Whoever follows Me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.

***Revelation 2:1** These are the words of Him who holds the seven stars in his right hand and walks among the seven golden lampstands:

***Revelation 2:2-4** I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. And you have tested those who say they are apostles and are not and have found them liars; and you have persevered and have patience, and have labored for My name's sake and have not become weary. Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have left your first love.

***Revelation 2:5** Look how far you have fallen! Turn back to me and do the works you did at first. If you don't repent, I will come and remove your lampstand from its place among the churches.

Ephesians 5:27 that he might present to himself the assembly (ekklesia) in glory, not having spot or wrinkle, or any of such things, but that it may be holy and unblemished:

***Revelation 2:8b** These things says the First and the Last, who was dead, and came to life:

***Revelation 2:9-11** I know your works, tribulation, and poverty (but you are rich); and *I know* the blasphemy of those who say they are Jews and are not but are a synagogue of Satan. Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.

***Revelation 2:11** He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. He who overcomes shall not be hurt by the second death.

***Revelation 2:12b** He who has the sharp two-edged sword:

***Revelation 2:13-15** I know where you live - where Satan has his throne. Yet you remain true to My name. You did not renounce your faith in Me not even in the days of Antipas, My faithful witness, who was put to death in your city where Satan lives. Nevertheless, I have a few things against you: There are some among you who hold to the teaching of Balaam, who taught Balak to entice the Israelites to sin so

that they ate food sacrificed to idols and committed sexual immorality. Likewise, you also have those who hold to the teaching of the Nicolaitans.

***Numbers 25:1-3** And Israel abode in Shittim, and the people began to commit whoredom with the daughters of Moab.

***Hebrews 10:26** For if we go on sinning deliberately after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins.

***Revelation 2:18b** These things says the Son of God who has eyes like a flame of fire, and His feet like the fine brass.

***Revelation 2:19-23** I know your deeds, your love and faith, your service and perseverance, and that you are now doing more than you did at first. Nevertheless, I have this against you: You **tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophet**. By her teaching she misleads my servants into sexual immorality and the eating of food sacrificed to idols. I have given her time to repent of her immorality, but she is unwilling. So I will cast her on a bed of suffering, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, **unless they repent of her ways**.

***Revelation 2:23** I will strike her children dead. Then all the churches will know that I am He who searches hearts and minds, and I will repay each of you according to your deeds.

***Revelation 2:24** Now to you I say, and to the rest in Thyatira, **as many as do not have this doctrine**, who have not known the depths of Satan, as they say, **I will put on you no other burden**.

***Revelation 2:25,26** But hold fast what you have till I come. And he who overcomes, and keeps My works until the end, to him I will give power over the nations.

***Revelation 3:1b** These things says He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars; I know your works, that you have a name that you are alive, but you are dead.

***Revelation 3:2-5** **Be watchful**, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die, for I have not found your works perfect before God. Remember therefore how you have received and heard; **hold fast and repent**. Therefore, **if**

you will not watch, I will come upon you as a thief, and you will not know what hour I will come upon you.

***Revelation 3:4-5** You have a few names even in Sardis who have not defiled their garments, and I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life; but I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels.

***Revelation 3:1b** These things says He who is holy, He who is true, He who has the key of David, He who opens and no one shuts and shuts and no one opens.

***Jeremiah 3:17** At that time they will call Jerusalem the Throne of the Lord, and all nations will gather in Jerusalem to honor the name of the Lord. No longer will they follow the stubbornness of their evil hearts.

***Revelation 3:8,10-12a** I know your works. See, I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it; for you have a little strength, have kept My word, and have not denied My name. ¹⁰ Because you have kept My command to persevere, I also will keep you from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth. ¹¹ Behold, I am coming quickly! Hold fast what you have, that no one may take your crown. ¹² He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall go out no more.

***Revelation 3:15-19** I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I could wish you were cold or hot. So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth. Because you say, 'I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing—and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked— I counsel you to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see. As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and repent.

***Revelation 3:21** To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.

***Exodus 27:20** And you shall command the Children of Israel that they shall bring to you olive oil that is clear, crushed, for illumination to light a lamp continually.

II Corinthians 4:6-11 For God who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to bring to light the knowledge of the glory of God on the face of [Jesus] Christ. But we hold this treasure* in earthen vessels, that the surpassing power may be of God and not from us. We are afflicted in every way, but not constrained; perplexed, but not driven to despair persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed; always carrying about in the body the dying of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be manifested in our body. For we who live are constantly being given up to death for the sake of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may be manifested in our mortal flesh.
