



Torah Portion Tzav with Spiritual Warfare Part I
March 30, 2024; 20 Adar II, 5784
Leviticus 6:1-8:36; Jeremiah 7:21-8:3, 9:22-23; John 11:47-56

***Luke 21:25 -26** And there will be signs in the sun, in the moon, and in the stars; and on the earth distress of nations, with perplexity, the sea and the waves roaring; Men will faint from fear and anxiety over what is coming upon the earth, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken....

***Psalm 89:14** Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; Mercy and truth go before You.

***Psalm 119:18&24** Open my eyes that I may see **wonderous things from Your law.**(Your instructions) Your testimonies are also my delight and my counselors.

***I Samuel 15:22a** Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice....

***Leviticus 6:1** HaShem spoke to Moses, saying Command (TZAV) Aaron and his sons,

***Leviticus 6:2 (Chumash)**This is the procedure of the burnt-offering. It is the burnt-offering that stays on the pyre on the Altar all the night until the morning and the fire of the Altar shall be kept burning on it.

***Leviticus 9:24** Fire came from the LORD and consumed the burnt offering and the fat portions on the altar. And when all the people saw it, they shouted and fell facedown.

***Revelation 2:4** Nevertheless I have this against you, because thou has left thy first love.

***I Corinthians 13:4-8** It (love) does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails.

***I John 4:18** There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love.

***Exodus 13:21**...He went before them as a pillar of cloud during the day and a pillar of flame at night.

***Leviticus 6:13** The fire is to be kept burning. The fire must never go out.

***Exodus 40:36-38** The Israelites set out whenever the cloud was taken up from the tabernacle throughout all the stages of their journey. If the cloud was not taken up, they did not set out until the day it was taken up. **For the cloud of the Lord was over the tabernacle by day, and there was a fire inside the cloud by night, visible to the entire house of Israel throughout all the stages of their journey.**

***Acts 2:2-3** Suddenly a sound like that of a violent rushing wind came from heaven, and it filled the whole house where they were staying. **They saw tongues like flames of fire that separated and rested on each one of them.**

***Leviticus 26:11-12** I will place my residence among you, and I will not reject you. **I will walk among you and be your God, and you will be my people.**

***2 Corinthians 6:16** And what agreement does the temple of God have with idols? For we are the temple of the living God, as God said: I will dwell and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people.

***Leviticus 1:2** Command Aaron and his sons, saying; This is the procedure of the burnt offering: It is the **burnt-offering that stays on the pyre on the Altar all the night until the morning;** and the **fire of the Altar shall be kept burning on it.**

***Psalm 141:2** Let my prayer be **counted as incense** before you, and the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice!

***Revelation 8:3-4** And another angel came and stood at the altar with a golden censer, and he was given **much incense** to **offer with the prayers of all the saints** on the golden altar before the throne, and the **smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints,** rose before God from the hand of the angel.

***Hebrews 6:11-12** **11** We want **each of you to show this same diligence to the very end, so that what you hope for may be fully realized.** We do not want you to become lazy, but to imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised.

***Galatians 6:9** Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.

***Colossians 3:23** Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters.

***Jeremiah 6:16-19** Thus says the LORD: Stand in the ways and see, and ask for the old paths, where the good way is and walk in it; then you will find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk in it. Also, I set watchmen over you, saying, Listen to the sound of the trumpet! But they said, We will not listen. Therefore, hear you nations and know, O congregation what is among them. Hear, O earth! Behold, I will certainly bring calamity on this people - The fruit of their thoughts, because they have not heeded My words nor My law, but rejected it.

***Jeremiah 7:21-23** Thus says the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel: Add your burnt offerings to your sacrifices and eat meat. For I did not speak to your fathers, or command them in the day that I brought them out of the land of Egypt, concerning burnt offerings or sacrifices. But this is what I commanded them, saying, Obey My voice, and I will be your God, and you shall be My people. And walk in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well with you.

***Jeremiah 7:26&28** Yet they did not obey Me or incline their ear but stiffened their neck. They did worse than their fathers..... So you shall say to them, This is a nation that does not obey the voice of the LORD their God nor receive correction. Truth has perished and has been cut off from their mouth.

***Jeremiah 6:21-23** Therefore thus says the Lord: Behold, I will lay stumbling blocks before this people, And the fathers and the sons together shall fall on them. The neighbor and his friend shall perish. Thus says the Lord: Behold, a people comes from the north country, And a great nation will be raised from the farthest parts of the earth. They will lay hold on bow and spear; They are cruel and have no mercy; Their voice roars like the sea; And they ride on horses, As men of war set in array against you, O daughter of Zion.

2 Peter 3:11-13 Since everything will be destroyed in this way, what kind of people ought you to be? You ought to live holy and godly lives as you look forward to the day of God and speed its coming.

***2 Corinthians 10:4-5** The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

***Hebrews 7:27** He (Yeshuah) has no need, like those high priests, to offer sacrifices daily, first for his own sins and then for those of the people, since He did this once for all when he offered up himself.

***Luke 22:52b-53** Have you come out, as against a robber, with swords and clubs? When I was with you daily in the temple, you did not try to seize Me. But this is your hour, and the power of darkness.

***Luke 23:3** Then Pilate asked Him, saying, Are You the King of the Jews? He answered him and said, It is as you say.

***Luke 23:9** tells us that Jesus did not work miracles on demand for Herod, nor did He answer the large number of questions that Herod put to Him that day. As a result of His silence, the following verse tells us,

***Luke 23:10** And the chief priests and scribes stood and vehemently accused him.

***Matthew 27:26** Then he released Barabbas to them; and when he had scourged Yeshua, he delivered him to be crucified.

***Isaiah 52:14** As many were astonished at You; So His visage was so marred more than any man and his form more than the sons of men.

***Isaiah 53:5** We are healed by the stripes of Yeshua.....

***Matthew 4:24** Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments and those who were demon possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them.

***Psalm 107:20** He sent His word and healed them, And delivered them from their destructions.

***I Peter 3:24** who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we having died to sins, might live for righteousness - by whose stripes you were healed.

***Philippians 2:5-8** Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross!

***Isaiah 52:14** Just as many were astonished at you, So His visage was marred more than any man, and His form, more than the sons of men.

***Colossians 2:13-14** When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins, having canceled the charge of our legal indebtedness, which stood against us and condemned us; he has taken it away, nailing it to the cross.

***I John 5:13** These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; *that ye may know that ye have eternal life*, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.

***I John 2:2** He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.

***2 Corinthians 5:21** For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

***2 Thessalonians 2:13** God saved us and called us to a holy calling, not because of our works but because of his own purpose and grace, which he gave us in Christ Jesus before the ages began.

***Isaiah 40:31** But those who **hope in the Lord** will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.
