



*Torah Portion Miketz - At the End - The Wrath and the Bride*

*December 16, 2023 - Tevet 4 , 5784*

*Genesis :1-44:17; I Kings 3:1-4:1; Luke 2:13-29*

**\*Genesis 40:14-15** When all goes well with you, **remember me** and show me kindness; **mention me to Pharaoh** and **get me out of this prison**. For I was forcibly carried off from the land of the Hebrews, and even here, I have done nothing to deserve being put in a dungeon.

**\*I Peter 3:14** But even if you should suffer for what is right, you are blessed. Do not fear their threats ; do not be frightened.

**\*2 Timothy 2:3-8** Endure suffering along with me, as a good soldier of Messiah Yeshua. Soldiers don't get tied up in the affairs of civilian life, for then they cannot please the officer who enlisted them. And athletes cannot win the prize unless they follow the rules. And hardworking farmers should be the first to enjoy the fruit of their labor. Think about what I am saying. The Lord will help you understand all these things. Always remember that Yeshua HaMashiach, a descendant of King David, was raised from the dead. This is the Good News I preach.

**\*Genesis 40:23** Yet the chief butler did not remember Joseph, but forgot him.

**\*Genesis 41:1** Then it came to pass, **at the end of two full years**, that Pharaoh had a dream; and behold, he stood by the river.

**\*Acts 23:34-35** And when the governor had read it, he asked what province he was from. And when he understood that he was from Cilicia, he said, I will hear you when your accusers also have come. And he commanded him to be kept in Herod's Praetorium.

**\*Jeremiah 32: 28-30** Therefore thus saith the Lord, Behold, **I will give this city into the hand of the Chaldeans, and into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babel**, and he shall take it. And the Chaldeans shall come and fight against this city, and set fire on this city, and burn it with the houses, upon whose roofs they have offered incense unto Baal, and poured drink offerings unto other gods, to provoke me unto anger. For the children of Israel, and the children of Judah have surely done evil before me, from their youth: for the children of Israel have surely provoked me to anger with the works of their hands, saith the Lord.

**\*Jeremiah 38:2-6** -Thus says the Lord: He who stays in this city shall die by the sword, by famine, and by pestilence, but he who goes out to the Chaldeans shall live. He shall have his life as a prize of war, and live. Thus says the Lord: This city shall surely be given into the hand of the army of the king of Babylon and be taken. Then the officials said to the king, Let this man be put to death, for he is weakening the hands of the soldiers who are left in this city, and the hands of all the people, by speaking such words to them. For this man is not seeking the welfare of this people, but their harm. King Zedekiah said, Behold, he is in your hands, for the king can do nothing against you. So they took Jeremiah and cast him into the cistern of Malchiah, the king's son, which was in the court of the guard, letting Jeremiah down by ropes. And there was no water in the cistern, but only mud, and Jeremiah sank in the mud.

**\*Jeremiah 38:16b** I will not put you to death or deliver you into the hand of these men who seek your life.

**\*John 16:32-33** Look, an hour is coming and has already come when you will be scattered, each to his own home, and you will leave Me all alone. Yet I am not alone, because the Father is with Me. I have told you these things so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world.

**\*Genesis 41:11-12** And there with us was a youth, a Hebrew, a slave of the Chief of the Butchers; and we related them to him, and he interpreted for us our dreams; each man according to his dream he interpreted.

**\*Genesis 41:14** So Pharaoh sent and called for Joseph, and they pulledrushed him from the pit. He shaved and changed his clothes, and he came to Pharaoh.

**\*RevelationRevelaion 22:12** And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work.

**\*Malachi 3:1** And the Lord, whom you seek, Will suddenly come to His temple, even the Messenger of the covenant, In whom you delight. Behold, He is coming, says the LORD of hosts.

**\*Genesis 41:16** Joseph answered Pharaoh, saying, That is beyond me; it is God who will respond with the welfare of Pharaoh.

**\*Genesis 1:37-39** The plan seemed good to Pharaoh and all his officials. So Pharaoh asked them, Can we find anyone like this man, in whom is the spirit of God (Eloheim)? Then Pharaoh said to Joseph, Since God (Eloheim) has made all this known to you, there is no one so discerning and wise as you. You shall be in charge of my palace.....

**\*Exodus 5:2** But Pharaoh said, Who is the LORD (YOOD HEY VAV HEY), that I should obey his voice and let Israel go? I do not know the LORD (YOOD HEY VAV HEY), and moreover, I will not let Israel go.

**\*Genesis 41:33** Now Pharaoh should seek a man who is discerning and wise, and set him over the land of Egypt. Pharaoh should proceed and he should appoint appointees on the land and he shall prepare the land of Egypt during the seven years of abundance. ....

**\*Genesis 41:41-42** Then Pharaoh said to Joseph, See! I have placed you in charge of all the land of Egypt. Then Pharaoh removed the signet ring from his finger, put it on Joseph's finger, clothed him in garments of fine linen, and placed a gold chain around his neck.

**\*Genesis 41:45** Pharaoh gave Joseph the name Zaphenath-paneah, and he gave him Asenath daughter of Potiphera, priest of On, to be his wife. And Joseph took charge of all the land of Egypt.

**\*Genesis 41:46b** ...Joseph left from the presence of Pharaoh and he passed through all the land of Egypt.

**\*Genesis 41:49b** Joseph amassed grain like the sand of the sea in great abundance, until the point that he ceased counting, for there was no number.

**\*Genesis 41:50-51** Before the year of famine came, two sons were born to Joseph. Asenath, the daughter of Potiphera priest of On, bore them to him. **Joseph called the name of the firstborn Manasseh.** For, he said, God has made me forget all my hardship and all my father's house.

**\*Genesis 41:51** And the name of the second he called Ephraim: For God has caused me to be fruitful in the land of my affliction.

**\*Genesis 41:53** Come to an end did the seven years of abundance that were in the land of Egypt.

**\*Ezekiel 21:1** And the word of the Lord came unto me, saying, Son of man, set thy face toward Jerusalem, and drop thy word toward the holy places, and prophesy against the land of Israel, .....

**\*Ezekiel 21:1 & 30-31** Let the sword return to its sheath. In the place where you were created, in the land of your ancestry, I will judge you. I will pour out my wrath on you and breathe out my fiery anger against you; I will deliver you into the hands of brutal men, men skilled in destruction.

**\*Revelation 11:18** The nations were angry, and Your wrath has come, and the time of the dead that they should be judged.

**\*Revelation 14:10** he himself shall also drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out full strength into the cup of His indignation....

**\*Revelation 14:19** So the angel thrust his sickle into the earth and gathered the vine of the earth, and threw it into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

**\*Genesis 41:1** ....at the end of two full years.....

**\*Hosea 6:1-2** Come and let us return to the LORD; For He has torn, but He will heal us; He has stricken, but He will bind us up. After two days He will revive us; On the third day He will raise us up, that we may live in His sight.

**\*Genesis 27:30** Now it happened, as soon as Isaac had finished כָּלָה blessing Jacob, and Jacob had scarcely gone out from the presence of Isaac his father, that Esau his brother came in from his hunting.

**\*Mark 14:24-25** And He said to them, This is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many. Assuredly, I say to you, I will no longer drink of the fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God.

**\*Genesis 41:1** ....at the end of two full years.....

**\*Hosea 6:1-2** Come and let us return to the LORD; For He has torn, but He will heal us; He has stricken, but He will bind us up. After two days He will revive us; On the third day He will raise us up, that we may live in His sight.

**\*Daniel 12:1** At that time Michael shall stand up, the great prince who stands watch over the sons of your people; and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation, even to that time. And at that time your people shall be delivered, everyone who is found written in the book.

**\*Jeremiah 30:7** Alas! For that day is great so that none is like it; and it is the time of Jacob's trouble, but he shall be saved out of it.

**\*Matthew 24:21-22** For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake those days will be shortened.

**\*Matthew 24:9** Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake.

**\*Matthew 24:32-34** Now learn this parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near. So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near—at the doors!
